

Utility Relocations Between Queensway and Paisley Boulevard on Hurontario Street

Beginning Week of September 14, 2021

WHAT'S HAPPENING?

To accommodate construction of the Hurontario LRT, new watermain will need to be installed. Construction crews will be starting this work on Hurontario Street near the Queensway and moving north towards Paisley Boulevard. This work is scheduled for four weeks starting in the week of **September 14th, 2021**. Crews will be onsite from **7:00 am to 10:00 pm**. This work may need to be rescheduled due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

Please ensure any items, such as signs, benches and underground sprinklers on city owned land have been relocated prior to the beginning of construction. For details on your property boundaries, please refer to your land survey, or consult an Ontario Land Surveyor.

Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions. Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibrations caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work. Please watch for pedestrian detours in the area as some sidewalks will be temporarily closed. Lane reductions and temporary driveway closures will be required during this work. Access to properties will be maintained through at least one driveway or with the assistance of a Traffic Control Person.
