

Nighttime Work on the Lakeshore West Rail Corridor at Port Credit Station

December 2021 to February 2022 between the hours of 8 p.m. to 4 a.m.

WHAT'S HAPPENING?

Construction crews will be in the rail corridor at Port Credit GO Station near Hurontario Street from December 2021 to February 2022.

In order to complete the work safely and efficiently, crews will be onsite between the hours of 8 p.m. and 4 a.m. on weeknights, along with overnight weekend work when necessary. Metrolinx has not scheduled any work between December 24 2021 to January 3 2022.

Metrolinx has a noise bylaw exemption for this overnight work, however every effort will be made to minimize disruptions. Residents near the work site can expect to hear noise or feel vibration caused by construction equipment related to this work. Please note, work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
