

# Constuction begins on the Eaglewood Boulevard Bridge with Piling Activities at Mary Fix Creek

## What work is taking place?

Construction crews have mobilized to commence piling activities at Mary Fix Creek, adjacent to Oriole Avenue. These are some of the enabling works required to build the support system for Eaglewood Boulevard bridge structure. These activities are expected to occur Monday through Friday from **October 7, 2022, to October 28, 2022**. This critical infrastructure will allow for the construction of an improved intersection, connecting Eaglewood Boulevard in the east to Oriole Avenue in the west. Once in place, the new bridge structure will allow crews to decommission the existing intersection at Inglewood Drive.

In order to minimize the impacts to the surrounding community, crews will restrict piling activities to the **hours of 7 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on weekdays** to be compliant with the City of Mississauga permit requirements. These activities will not take place at night, on weekends, or statutory holidays and every effort will be made to end the daily piling activities by 3:30 p.m. to further mitigate the impacts to the neighbouring properties whenever possible. This notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and feel vibration caused by diesel hammers, trucks, excavators, and other construction equipment related to this work.

We understand that we are building this transformational transit project in a residential area and that construction-related noise and vibration are disruptive. We appreciate your patience and will complete this work as safely and efficiently as possible. We have a dedicated community relation team in place to work with residents and businesses in Peel Region through the construction and operation of this transformational project.

### TIMING

- Work is scheduled to take place between October 7, 2022, to October 28, 2022.
- There will not be overnight, weekend, or work on statutory holidays for these activities. Pile driving will occur on weekdays between 7 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. to minimize the impacts to the surrounding community.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

### TRAFFIC DETAILS

- This work is localized at Mary Fix Creek adjacent to Oriole Avenue.
- Traffic delays are expected where lane reductions already exist for utility and roadwork activities on Hurontario Street. There are no additional traffic impacts related to this work.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas (especially on Oriole Avenue and Inglewood Drive).
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

### WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and feel vibration caused by diesel hammers, trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, and other construction equipment related to this work.

### PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk access in the area could be affected.
- Watch for signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety. Please use the pedestrian pathway only and not the roadway.
