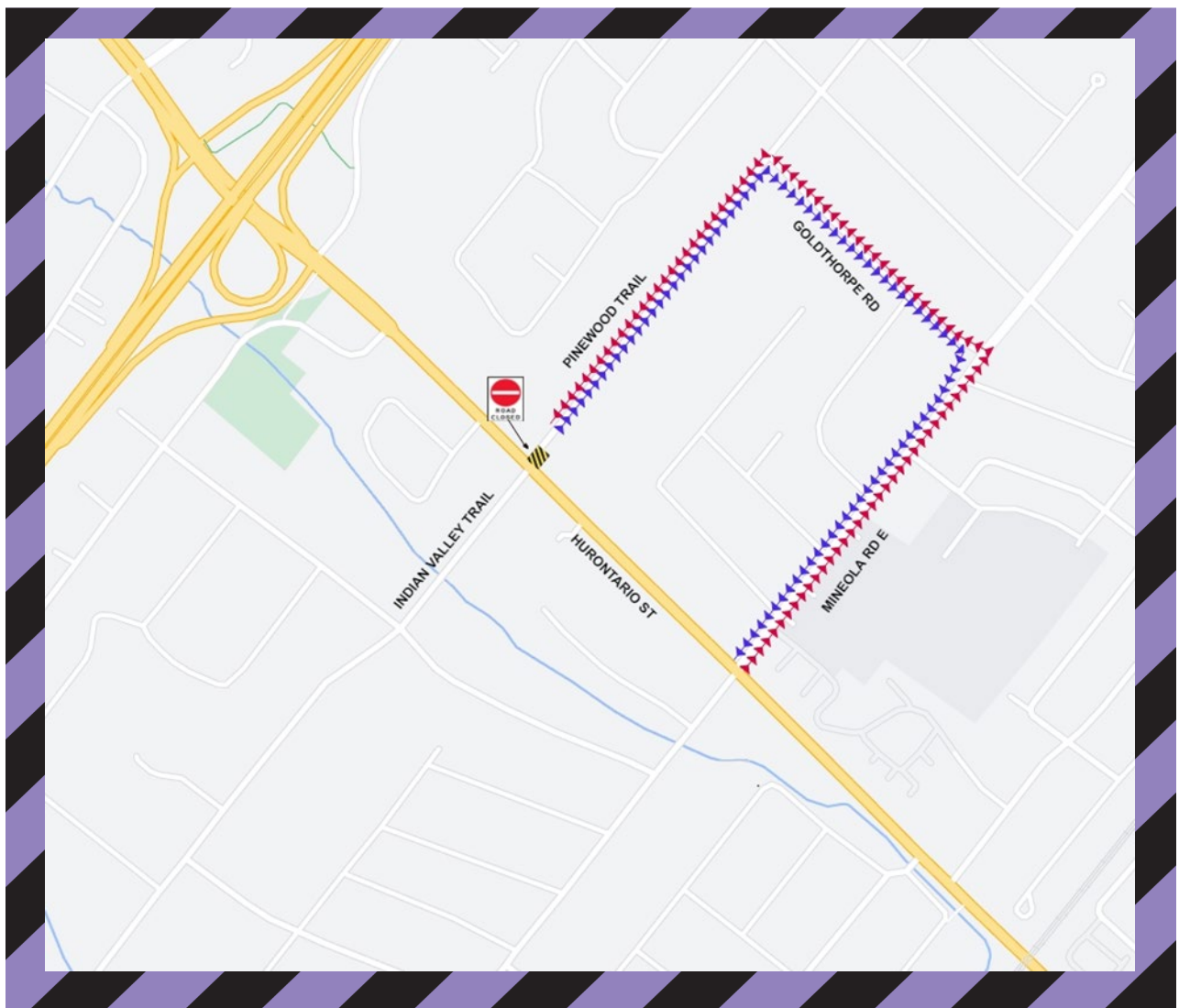


Road Closure at Pinewood Trail and Hurontario Street

Wednesday September 7, 2022 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.



What work is taking place?

Construction crews will be installing utilities along Hurontario Street that will also need to cross Pinewood Trail. This will result in a temporary closure of a portion of Pinewood Trail for the installation of watermain. Works are scheduled to take place **from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on September 7, 2022.**

Residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

During this closure, motorists can access Pinewood Trail from Hurontario Street using the detour map provided. Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. If you require the most up-to-date information, please reach out to peel@metrolinx.com.



TIMING

- Pinewood Trail will be closed on:
 - **September 7, 2022 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.**
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Access to Pinewood Trail will be maintained through a detour from Hurontario Street, Mineola Road East and Goldthorpe Road.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching work zones.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- MiWay near the intersection will continue to operate with regular service.

- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stop as boarding areas may be relocated.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety
