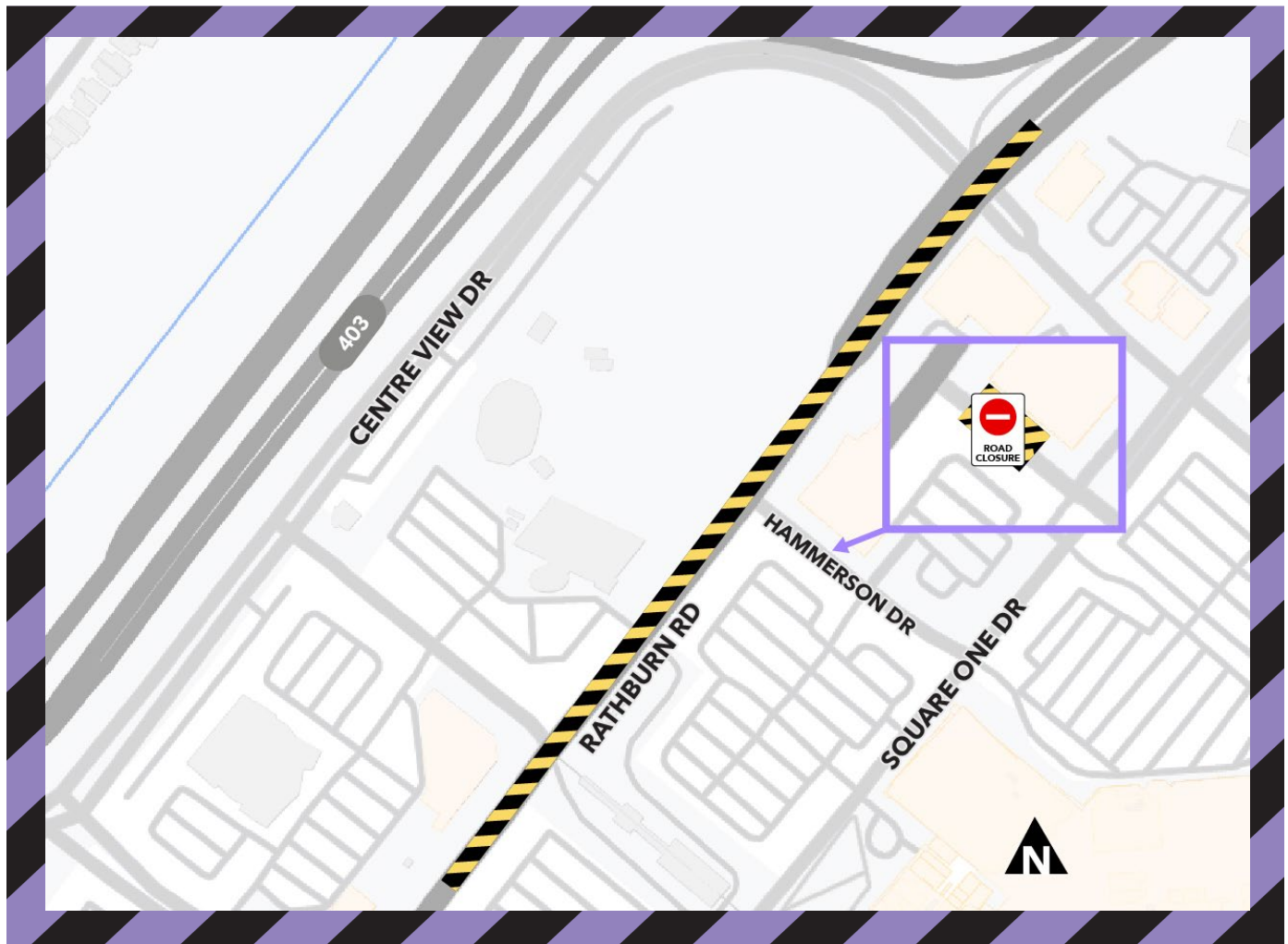


# Utility Relocation on Rathburn Road from Hurontario Street to Duke of York Boulevard

Beginning August 30, 2021



## What work is taking place?

To accommodate construction of the Hurontario LRT, new watermain and sanitary lines will need to be installed on Rathburn Road. This work will start on Rathburn Road at the Hurontario overpass and will move west towards Duke of York Boulevard. The work is tentatively expected to start on August 30, 2021 and will be completed in mid-November 2021. Traffic configuration will be one eastbound lane, one west bound lane, and exclusive left turn lanes at intersections.

In late September and October, vehicular traffic will be restricted at the entrance of Hammerson Boulevard and Rathburn Road. For each occurrence, the intersection will be closed for 24 hours to safely complete watermain installations. Road closure and detour signs will be posted to keep residents and businesses informed of this closure. Driveways to properties will not be impacted during this work. Once dates have been scheduled for this work, advanced notice will be provided to the impacted community.



### TIMING

- Work is scheduled to start in late August and will last for approximately three months.
- Work will generally occur between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. However, night shifts and weekend works may be scheduled as required.
- Two temporary Hammerson Drive closures will be implemented for 24 hours.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

### TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Lane reductions will be required on Rathburn Road.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Temporary traffic signals will be installed.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

### WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Access to properties will be maintained through at least one driveway or with the assistance of a Traffic Control Person.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

### TRANSIT DETAILS

- MiWay will continue to operate with regular service.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.
- A temporary pedestrian pathway will be provided to access the boarding areas.

### PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk access in the area could be affected.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians & cyclists as detours may be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

### PROPERTY DETAILS

- Please ensure any personal belongings, such as signs, benches and underground sprinklers on city owned land have been relocated prior to the beginning of construction.
- For details on your property boundaries, please refer to your land survey, or consult an Ontario Land Surveyor.
