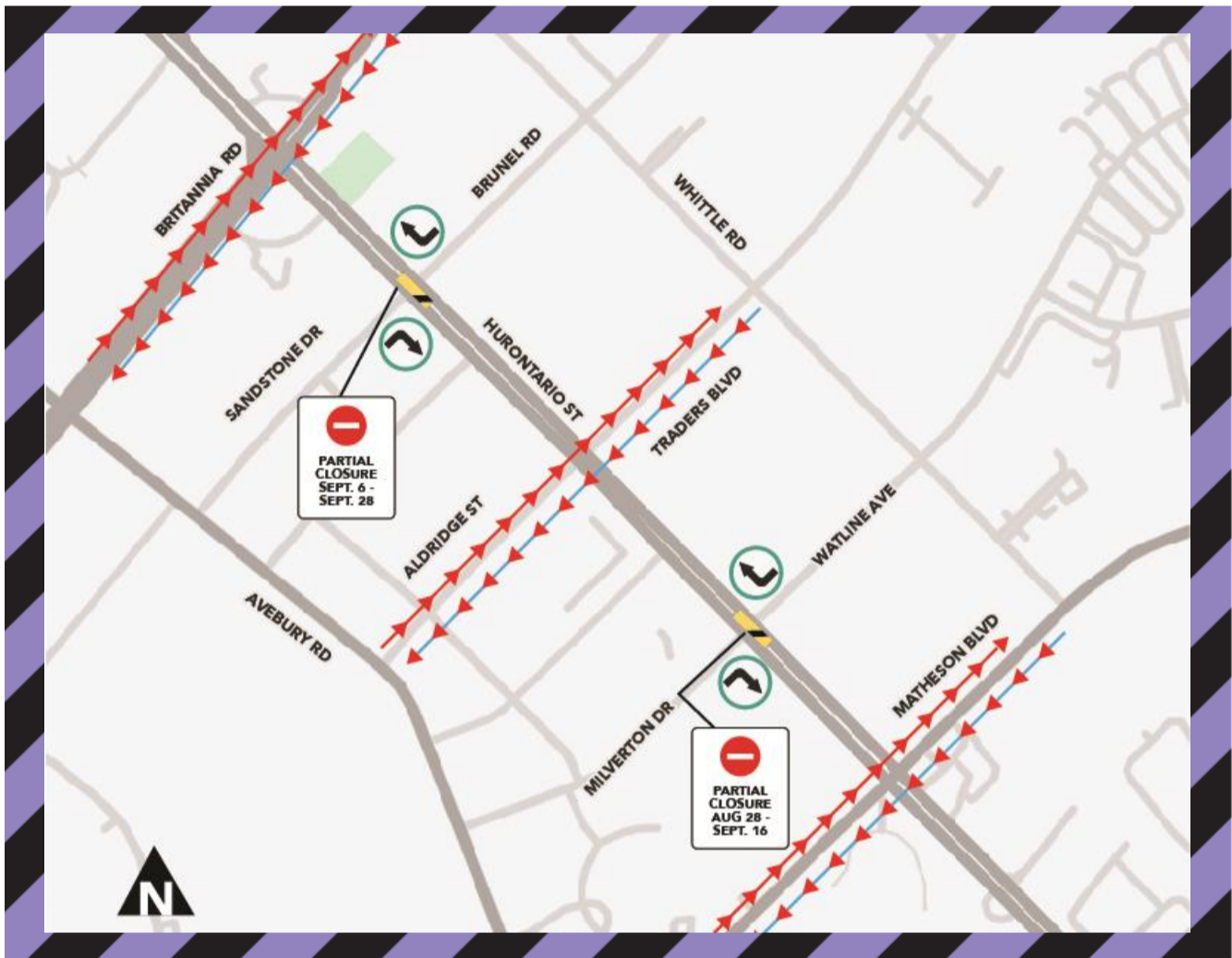


Partial Intersection Closures for Track Installations along Hurontario Street

Milverton Drive/Watline Avenue: August 28, 2022 – September 16, 2022

Sandstone Drive/Brunel Road: September 6, 2022 – September 28, 2022



What work is taking place?

For the construction of the LRT, tracks will be laid along the centre guideway of Hurontario Street between Matheson Boulevard and Britannia Road, requiring partial east-west intersection closures in the area. This work is scheduled at the intersection of **Milverton Drive/Watline Avenue and Hurontario Street from 10pm on August 28, 2022 until September 16, 2022**. The partial closure at **Sandstone Drive/Brunel Road and Hurontario Street is scheduled from from 10pm on September 6, 2022 until September 28, 2022**. Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. Please watch for signage in the area for any updates.

Construction occurs at every other intersection to allow for motorist and transit detours. Once completed, track installations along Hurontario Steet will continue at Aldridge Street/Traders Blvd East and Matheson Boulevard. Further notification announcing dates for this work will be distributed.

Construction work at these intersections is scheduled for 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Two northbound lanes, two southbound lanes and right-turn movements are maintained on Hurontario Street. Motorists, including emergency vehicles, will not be able to cross Hurontario Street, including left-turns, at these intersections and are encouraged to follow signed detour routes. Pedestrian crossings of Hurontario Street will be maintained at a signalized crosswalk. Traffic signal timings will be adjusted to keep people moving.

Transit services will be impacted, including MiWay routes 25 and 70. Please visit www.miway.ca/updates for updates on your bus route.

TIMING

- Work at Milverton Drive/Watline Avenue is scheduled from August 28, 2022 until September 16, 2022
- Work at Sandstone Drive/Brunel Road is scheduled from September 6, 2022 until September 28, 2022
- Construction is scheduled to occur 24/7
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Eastbound and westbound movements will not be permitted across the intersections.
- Left turns will not be permitted at the intersections.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Temporary traffic signal heads will be bagged to align with the lane closures.

TRANSIT IMPACT DETAILS

- MiWay routes 25 and 70 detoured due to partial intersection closures.
- Due construction activities along Hurontario Street, delays can be expected on Züm route 502 and MiWay routes 17, 39, 43 and 103.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.



WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Access to properties will be maintained.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when walking or cycling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing the public such as detours and dismounting.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians across Hurontario Street as only one east/west crosswalk will be provided at all Hurontario Street intersections.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

PROPERTY DETAILS

- Crews will not require property access for track installation.
