WHAT'S HAPPENING?

As utility upgrades progress in the area, crews will be installing new electrical infrastructure on Hurontario Street between Queensway and Dundas Street on Sunday October 23, 2022. The work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work. To complete the work safely and efficiently, crews will be working onsite overnight when vehicular and bus traffic is at a minimum. Please note, work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
