

Temporary Traffic Restrictions at Topflight Drive and Edwards Boulevard

Beginning July 12th, 2021



What work is taking place?

As part of the Hurontario Light Rail Transit Project, watermain and sewer infrastructure installation works will take place on Topflight Drive. During this work, access to Topflight Drive will be limited to only traffic travelling west towards Hurontario. Eastbound access to Topflight Drive will be available via Derry Road and Edwards Boulevard. This work may cause some driveway and sidewalk impacts along Topflight Drive and Edwards Boulevard, impacted properties will be notified as more information becomes available.

TIMING

- Traffic restrictions on Topflight Drive is scheduled to start on July 12th, 2021 and will last approximately eight weeks.
- Work will generally occur between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. However, night shifts and weekend works may be scheduled as required.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Topflight Dr. will be limited to westbound traffic only.
- Edwards Blvd. will be reduced to one lane in each direction.
- Traffic detour signs will be posted in the area directing vehicles towards Derry Rd. and Edwards Blvd.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching construction.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Access to properties will always be maintained through at least one driveway or with the assistance of a Traffic Control Person.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- The Northbound bus stop #4006 at Hurontario St. & Kingsway and #1908 at Hurontario St. & Topflight Dr. will be impacted. Northbound transit users can alternatively use the stop #1907 at Hurontario St. and Derry Rd.
- The Southbound bus stop #4213 at Hurontario St. and Kingsway Dr. and #2518 at Hurontario St. and Derry Rd. will be impacted. Southbound transit users can alternatively use stop #1912 at Hurontario St. and Derry Rd.
- Due to lane reductions, delays can be expected on MiWay Route 17.

- Customers may also use the following stops along Edwards Boulevard:

Northbound:

1154 (Edwards Blvd. at Export Blvd.)

1852 (Edwards Blvd. at Statesman Dr.)

Southbound

1163 (Edwards Blvd. at Export Blvd.)

1148 (Edwards Blvd. at Derry Rd.)

- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.
- A temporary pedestrian pathway will be provided to access the boarding areas.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when walking or cycling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing the public such as detours and dismounting.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

NOISE BYLAW EXEMPTION

- In 2017, Mississauga City Council approved general exemptions to the Noise Control By-law and selected roadway closures, at the discretion of the Commissioner of Transportation and Works for the duration of Hurontario LRT construction.
- Generally, the exemptions can allow for major construction works to take place from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m. seven days per week, and minor activities that generate minimal noise to take place 24 hours per day, seven days per week.
