

Night Work: Vegetation Removal between Birchmount Road and Kennedy Road

As soon as late-December 2021 to March 2022



What work is taking place?

Crews will be mobilizing to the northern portion of the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor between Kennedy Road and Wolcott Avenue area. Once on site, crews will begin removing trees and other vegetation within the Metrolinx Right-of-Way.

What to Expect

Residents can expect to see construction vehicles and equipment entering and exiting the site from the gates located 347 Kennedy Rd and 61 Milnes Ave, and the work take place within the rail corridor along the northside.

Information as of: November 9, 2021

For safety, work is required to take place at night when trains are not running due to the close proximity to the rail corridor. Due to the nature of this work, noise, vibration, dust and site lighting can be anticipated.

Work crews will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents, and the following mitigation measures will be implemented:

- No idling of non-essential equipment
- Keeping reverse operations to a minimum
- Using vehicles and equipment with efficient muffling devices
- Pointing lights away from residential windows
- Routing trucks on main roads where possible

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur nightly between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., five (5) days per week (Monday night to Saturday morning)
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

LOCATION

- Between Wolcott Avenue and Kennedy Road, adjacent to the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Increased traffic volume at the entrance/exit gates and staging will be within the rail corridor.
- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- Pedestrians will not be impacted at this time.
- TTC will not be impacted.

The new fourth track will improve journey times for all transit trips on the Lakeshore East Corridor, improve reliability and deliver more service within the City of Toronto.
