


Investigative Work Starting

December 2021



What is Happening?

As part of our investigative work for the GO Expansion program, there will be borehole drilling and monitoring well installation completed at various locations. Most locations are in the Morningside Avenue and West Rouge area (near Rouge Hill GO Station).

What to Expect?

Boreholes will be drilled and at some locations a monitoring well will be installed in order to collect subsurface soil samples and groundwater samples. Additional details are below:

- There will be a small crew (3-4 workers) drilling the boreholes
- A borehole is several meters deep
- At some locations, a monitoring well will be installed
 - A monitoring well will have a flush mount cover approximately 6 inches in diameter
- The locations are either on Metrolinx-owned property or on City boulevards
- Additional work at these locations (i.e., groundwater sampling) will be completed in February/March 2022
- Typical construction impacts, including noise, can be expected while the drilling work is being completed

HOURS OF WORK

- The borehole drilling will be completed on December 10 and December 15 during the daytime
 - Each borehole drilling takes approximately 3-4 hours to complete
- In February/March 2022, a worker will return to develop the monitoring wells and collect groundwater samples
 - Monitoring well development and groundwater sampling will be completed on separate days during the daytime, and will take approximately 1 hour to complete
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- There may be brief periods of time when the sidewalks adjacent to the Morningside Avenue and the West Rouge locations will be unavailable
- At some locations, there will be temporary traffic control in place as a portion of the lane will be closed
- As always, please take care when travelling near work sites.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No impacts to TTC, or other public transit modes are anticipated during this work.
