

# Temporary Laydown Area at Rouge Hill GO

November 2021



## What is Happening?

Rouge River Bridge Rehabilitation Project contractor will be using the north portion of the Rouge Hill GO Station parking lot as a temporary laydown area.

## What to Expect?

- Wooden ties will be delivered to the lot, assembled into track panels, loaded onto flatbed trucks, and then transported to the Rouge River Bridge
- Laydown area will be fenced off with temporary chain link fence
- Any night lighting will be directed away from houses as much as possible
- Construction noise can be expected, however, when possible noisy work will be completed during the daytime

## HOURS OF WORK

- The work will occur in the laydown area until December 17, 2021.
  - To complete the Rouge River Bridge project before summer 2022, there are unrestricted daytime and overnight work hours, as well as some weekend work
  - Flatbed trucks will transport track panels to the Rouge River Bridge during the weekends of November 26-28 and December 10-12
  - During these weekends, work hours will include both daytime and overnight hours
  - Updates to be provided in the Toronto East and Durham e-newsletters

## TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Traffic control flagmen will temporarily stop traffic for material/equipment delivery on East Avenue.
- As always, please take care when travelling near work sites.

## TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No service on the Lakeshore East line starting Friday, November 26 to Sunday, November 28
- No impacts to TTC, or other public transit modes are anticipated during this work.
