

Firewood Giveaway at Rouge Hill GO Station

What is Happening?

As part of the [Vegetation Management Program](#), Metrolinx and our contractor will be giving away firewood to the community in an effort to both divert waste and be a socially responsible and sustainable partner in the GTHA.

Details

Metrolinx is conducting a Vegetation Management Program on all of our corridors as we prepare for electrification of the GO network. Metrolinx and our contractors are inviting the community to pick up one full wheelbarrow of chopped firewood at Rouge Hill GO Station north parking lot on **Saturday, December 18 between 9 a.m. and 12 noon.**

What to Expect?

This is a drive-through event. Vehicles will enter the north parking lot off East Avenue. The south driveway of the north parking lot will be closed. Once in the parking lot, vehicles will be in a line leading to a pick-up point to receive their firewood. Each person will be responsible for loading their own vehicle.

- Traffic in the area may be a bit slower than usual as vehicles enter the north parking lot. Paid duty officers will be on site to assist.
