

Eglinton GO Station Tie Replacement

September 2021



What is Happening?

Work is starting to replace all rail, ballast and old hardwood ties (e.g. with new concrete ties), resulting in improved track reliability.

What to Expect?

GO Expansion continues to improve, update, and modernize our infrastructure. Enhancements to tracks, bridges, and stations are necessary to prepare our current service to meet tomorrow's needs. Maintenance work is also necessary to ensure that our services continue to run safely and efficiently.

- The track through Eglinton GO Station has been identified as requiring tie, ballast and rail replacements along the entire length of the station platform.
- Work includes positioning equipment, delivery of materials and pre-construction of concrete track panels in preparation for the replacement of existing track structure
- Work will take place in the corridor from Eglinton GO Station to McCowan District Park
- Construction noise can be expected during this work
 - Excavators, small crew and materials will be moving through the site
 - Noise monitoring equipment will be used to ensure the level of noise is within guidelines
- The customer parking lot on the north side of Eglinton Avenue will continue to be closed and this area will serve as the Preparation and Pre-construction Staging Area 2 (shown in image)

HOURS OF WORK

- The work will occur from early October to end of November, with possible breaks between the days worked.
- This project has both daytime and overnight work hours as follows: Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. - 6:00 a.m.
- Overnight work is needed in order to be able to access the corridor safely when there are less trains operating
- Residents can expect approximately 5-6 weeks of nightwork, however, there will be breaks in between
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances
