

# Eglinton GO Station Tie Replacement

April 18-25, 2022

## What is Happening?

Work is continuing with the replacement of all rail, ballast and ties resulting in improved track reliability.

## What to Expect?

Maintenance work is necessary to ensure that our services continue to run safely and efficiently. This weekend work is part of a larger tie replacement project. This work will include:

- Removal of 704 track meters of existing old wood ties track and installation of concrete ties track with new rail on Tracks 2 and 3 through the Eglinton GO Station
- Work will take place in the corridor near to Eglinton GO Station from Porchester Drive to McCowan District Park
- The customer parking lot on the north side of Eglinton Avenue will continue to be closed and this area will serve as a support area for this work
- Construction noise can be expected during this work
  - Excavators, large rail equipment, large crew and materials will be moving through the site
  - Noise monitoring equipment will be used to ensure the level of noise is within guidelines



## HOURS OF WORK

- This project has both daytime and overnight work hours
- Preparatory work for this track replacement will start on Monday, April 18th and will run throughout the week.
- The track replacement work will occur from Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> at 8:00 p.m. to Monday, April 25<sup>th</sup> at 06:00 a.m.
- Overnight work is needed to be able to access the corridor safely when there are fewer trains operating.
- Work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

## TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- There will be no service at the Eglinton GO Station from April 22<sup>nd</sup> at 8:00 p.m. to April 25<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 a.m.
- As always, please take care when travelling near work sites.

## TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No impacts to TTC, or other public transit modes are anticipated during this work.
