


Danforth Bridge Work and Traffic Impacts

Mid-July, 2021 to November 2022



What work is taking place?

Crews will be closing one lane of traffic in each direction, installing a temporary shoring system including piling, extending the existing center pier of the Danforth bridge to facilitate the installation of a future north track. Work on the Danforth bridge will be ongoing until November 2022 and updated construction notices will be sent in advance.

What to Expect

The inside lanes in both directions will be closed and the construction zone around the pier blocked off between Scotia Avenue and Eastwood Street. All traffic will use the outside lanes. The pedestrian underpasses will not be impacted. Traffic may move more slowly around the work zone. Residents can expect to see construction vehicles and equipment within the rail corridor, on Danforth Avenue, and in the surrounding areas, including pile driving equipment, dozer, crane, excavator, concrete trucks, and dump trucks. Due to the nature of this work, noise, vibration dust and site lighting can be anticipated.

When

Bridge work and traffic impacts will begin Mid-July to November 2022. This stage of work and traffic impacts will be ongoing until the end of August. Updated construction notices for the duration of this project will be sent in advance.

Where

Danforth Avenue between Warden Avenue and Eastwood Avenue.

Hours of Work

- Work will occur between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. five (5) days per week (Monday to Friday).
- Please note that dates and times are tentative, and work could be rescheduled.

Traffic and Pedestrian Details

- One lane in each direction will be closed.
- One lane in each direction will be maintained. Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.

Transit Information

- TTC bus stop, servicing bus route 20, located at Medford and Danforth Avenue will be relocated 50 metres west on Danforth Avenue.
