
Warden Avenue Bridge Construction Notice

July, 2021 to Summer 2022



What work is taking place?

Crews will be mobilizing to Warden Avenue, east of Danforth Avenue, in July 2021. Once on-site, crews will be reducing traffic to one lane in each direction to install a temporary shoring system and extending the existing center pier of the Metrolinx overpass bridge on Warden Avenue. This work will be ongoing for approximately two months.

What to Expect

Road users can expect to see the lanes closest to the pier, in each direction, closed and the construction zone around the pier blocked off between Danforth Avenue and Clonmore Drive. Traffic may move slower through the work zone. Residents can expect to see construction vehicles and equipment on Warden Avenue and in the surrounding areas, including pile driving equipment, dozer, crane, excavator, concrete trucks, and dump trucks. Due to the nature of this work, noise, vibration, dust and site lighting can be anticipated.

Widening the pier is the first step towards widening the bridge to carry an additional track. Once the pier is widened, the contractor will widen the abutments and then the bridge deck. Traffic impacts will change as the work progresses. Updates will be provided ahead of any changes. The total bridge widening work is expected to take about a year.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. five (5) days per week (Monday to Friday).
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Traffic will be reduced to single lane conditions in both directions.
- Pedestrians will not be impacted at this time.
- TTC will not be impacted.
- Advanced notice of traffic impacts will be provided through our weekly e-newsletter.
- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.

PROJECT INFORMATION

- We're making improvements today to bring you even more service in the future. Preparatory early works

 addition of a fourth track and electrification infrastructure on the Lakeshore East line.

The new fourth track will improve journey times for all transit trips on the Lakeshore East Corridor, improve reliability and deliver more service within the City of Toronto.
