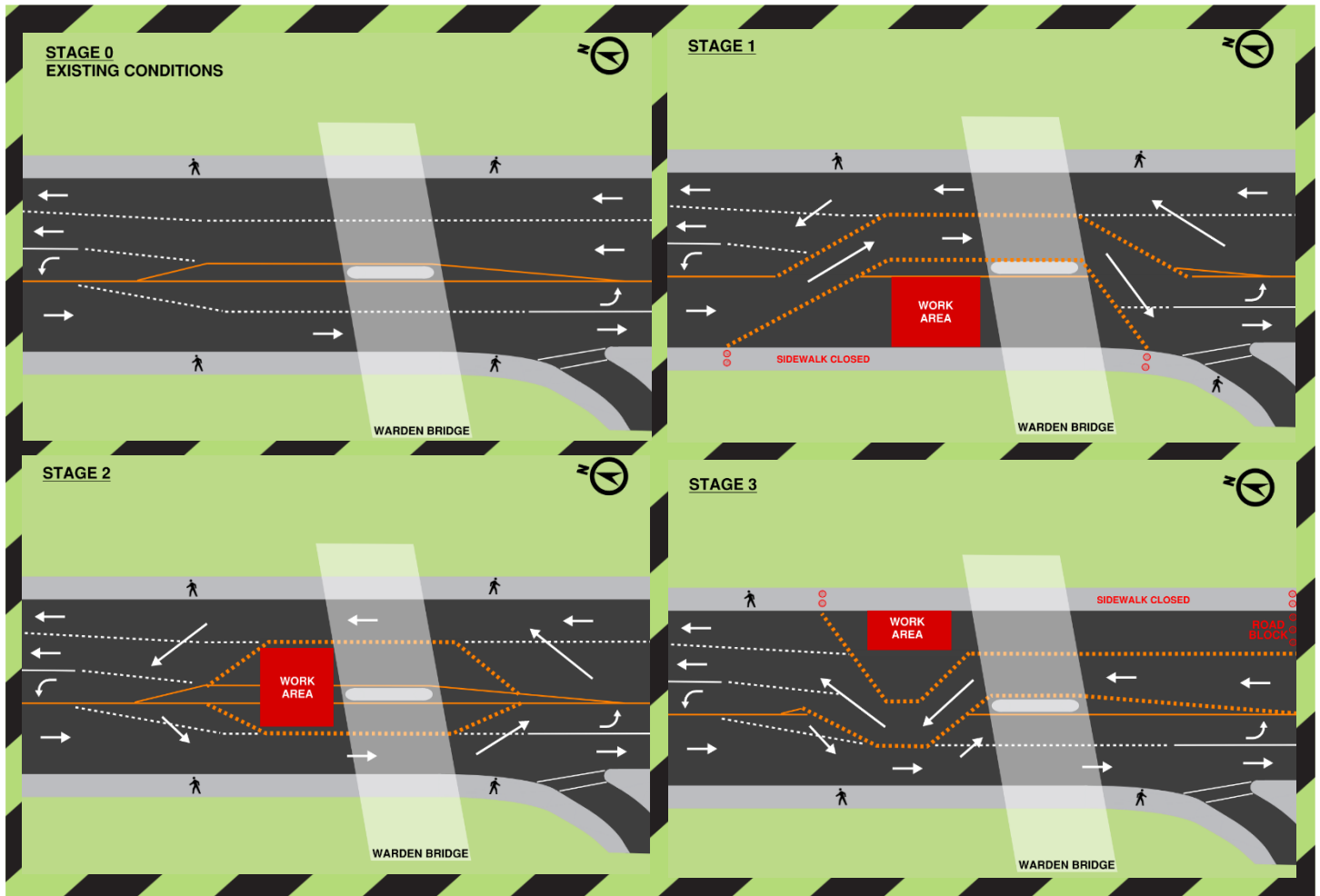


Warden Avenue Storm Sewer Work

July 5, 2021



What work is taking place?

Crews will be mobilizing to Warden Avenue east of Danforth Avenue in July 2021. Once on-site, crews will be reducing traffic to one lane in each direction, installing a new catch basin utility hole on the west side of the road, and connecting it to the existing sewage system to prepare for future bridge works. Sewage work on Warden Avenue will be ongoing for approximately one month.

What to Expect

Road users can expect Warden Avenue to be reduced to a single lane in each direction between Danforth Avenue and Clonmore Drive for the full duration of the work. Lane closures will change as the work progresses.

The work will occur in three stages:

Stage 1: The west side of the road will be closed for roadwork, and northbound and southbound traffic will flow through the east side of the road. The east sidewalk will be closed.

Stage 2: Traffic will move to the outside lanes while the lanes closest to the median will be closed. Both east and west side walks will remain open.

Stage 3: The east side of the road will be closed for roadwork, and both directions of traffic will flow through the west side of the road. The west sidewalk will be closed.

Traffic may move more slowly through the work zones. Residents can expect to see construction vehicles and equipment within the rail corridor, on Warden Avenue, and in the surrounding areas, including asphalt and concrete saws, excavators, concrete trucks, rollers, and dump trucks. Due to the nature of this work, noise, vibration dust and site lighting can be anticipated.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. five (5) days per week (Monday to Friday).
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- One lane in each direction will be closed.
- Advanced notice of traffic impacts will be provided through our weekly e-newsletter.
- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.

PROJECT INFORMATION

- We're making improvements today to bring you even more service in the future. Preparatory early works are getting underway on the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor Expansion project in Toronto. This project covers the area between Pape Avenue and Kennedy Road. Completing this work will enable the future addition of a fourth track and electrification infrastructure on the Lakeshore East line.
- Electrification is a key part of building a quieter, faster, more efficient network across the region. The new fourth track will improve journey times for all transit trips on the Lakeshore East Corridor, improve reliability and deliver more service within the City of Toronto.
