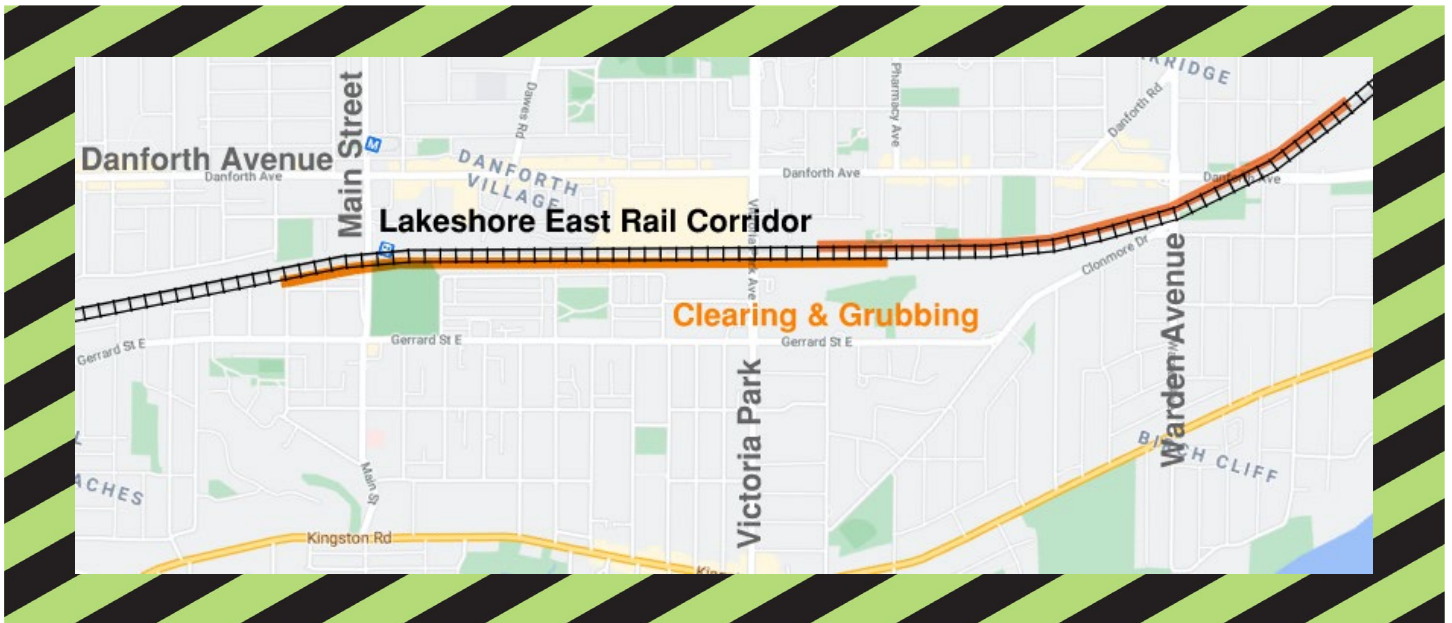


# Lakeshore East Early Works: Clearing & Grubbing

February 15, 2021



## What work is taking place?

Crews will be mobilizing to the Lakeshore East rail corridor on February 15, 2021. Once onsite, crews will begin removing trees and other vegetation along the south side of the rail corridor within the Metrolinx Right-of-Way from Norwood Road to east of Victoria Park Road and along the north side of the corridor from Victoria Park Avenue to east of Warden Avenue. Work will be ongoing until March 31, 2021.

There will be two (2) weeks of overnight work required beginning in early March to install jersey barriers near Warden and Danforth bridges between the hours of 9:00 pm - 6:00 am. There will be a mobile crane, a flatbed truck and site lighting associated with this work.

## What to Expect

Residents will see construction vehicles and equipment within the rail corridor, including a tree feller, feller buncher, mulcher, dozer, excavator, and dump trucks. Residents should expect some noise, vibration, dust, and site lighting.



## HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur between the hours of 7:00 am and 5:00 pm, five (5) days per week (Monday to Friday).
- Work will occur between the hours of 9:00 pm – 6:00 am from March 1, 2021 for two (2) weeks near Warden & Danforth bridges (Monday to Friday).
- Additional work may be required during the evening hours. Advanced notice will be provided through our weekly regional e-newsletter.
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

## TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Minimal traffic impacts are anticipated with this work. Where traffic impacts are expected, notice will be provided through our weekly regional e-newsletter.
- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- No pedestrian impacts are anticipated with this work.

## TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No impacts to TTC or other public transit modes are anticipated during this work.
