

# Gate Installation at Chesterton Shores Level Crossing

June 12, 2020



## What work is taking place?

Construction will be taking place at Chesterton Shores level crossing during the week of June 22. A gate is being installed at this level crossing which is located directly beside Rouge Hill GO Station. During gate installation, access to the Waterfront Trail will remain open.

Following the installation, the gate will remain open until further notice. At a future date, to address multiple safety concerns, the Chesterton Shores level crossing will be closing.

## Access to Waterfront Trail

There are two additional access points in the vicinity of Rouge Hill GO Station. The closest access is through a pedestrian tunnel at Rouge Hill GO Station. This access is approximately 250m (a three minute walk) from the current level crossing at Chesterton Shores and is accessible by elevator and stairs from the platform level. An alternate access point approximately 500m west of Rouge Hill Station is available via an underpass in the Port Union Village Common Park. This tunnel is approximately 15 feet wide and 10 feet high, and is also fully accessible.
