


Night Work: Utility Relocation and Grading

Mid-November 2021 to December 2022



What work is taking place?

Crews will be mobilizing to the area between Victoria Park Avenue and Kenworthy Avenue to perform work along the south side of the Lakeshore East rail corridor. The work will include installation of sediment control fence and tree protection fence, then clearing and grubbing followed by earthworks. The Loblaws parking lot at 50 Musgrave Street will be used to access the adjacent corridor for construction and delivery of materials.

What to Expect

Residents can expect to see construction vehicles and equipment in the rail corridor and the surrounding areas, including chainsaws, tree fellers, tree chippers, dozer, excavator, and dump trucks. Due to the nature of this work, noise, vibration, dust and site lighting can be anticipated. Work crews will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents. This includes:

- Reduced idling - whenever possible, idling will be reduced or eliminated to minimize the accumulation of construction noise

- Limited reversing - when possible, reversing will be avoided to reduce the noise associated with backup alarms and monitors (installed on all construction equipment)
- Noise vibration monitoring - this has already been set up to ensure that noise levels are within the exposure limits

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur during the night, from 7:00 pm to 7:00 am, five (5) days per week (Monday to Friday).
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- The rail corridor will be accessed through the Loblaws parking lot at 50 Musgrave Street
- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- Traffic will not be impacted at this time.
- Pedestrians will not be impacted at this time.
- TTC will not be impacted.
- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.

PROJECT INFORMATION

- We're making improvements today to bring you even more service in the future. Preparatory early works are underway on the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor Expansion project in Toronto. This project covers the area between Pape Avenue and Kennedy Road. Completing this work will enable the future addition of a fourth track and electrification infrastructure on the Lakeshore East line.
- Electrification is a key part of building a quieter, faster, more efficient network across the region. The new fourth track will improve journey times for all transit trips on the Lakeshore East Corridor, improve reliability and deliver more service within the City of Toronto.
