


Weekend Work: Jones Ave. to Carlaw Ave.

Early November 2022 to Early December 2022



What work is taking place?

Crews will be mobilizing to the area between Jones Avenue and Carlaw Avenue in early November to perform preparatory work along the north and south sides of the Lakeshore East rail corridor. This work is to accommodate a track diversion which will allow for future construction to be completed on a faster timeline, minimizing disturbances to residents. The preparatory work includes construction of temporary crossing approaches, material deliveries, and tie replacements. Over the weekends of November 12, 2022 and November 26, 2022, crews will work to complete the track diversion. This work requires a reduction in GO service, so will be conducted on the weekends to minimize impacts to users. Please see below table for details.

Track Diversion, Weekend 1	November 11-14, 2022	Approx. 4 days	Day & Night Shift	Track diversion at the southern and centre tracks to support the addition of a future fourth track. Equipment for this work includes a hi-rail excavator, hi-rail boom truck, excavator, loader, and dump trucks.
Track Diversion, Weekend 2	November 25-28, 2022	Approx. 4 days	Day & Night Shift	Track diversion at the northern and centre tracks to support the addition of a future fourth track. Equipment for this work includes a hi-rail excavator, hi-rail boom truck, excavator, loader, and dump trucks.

* Please note that dates and times are approximate, and work could be rescheduled.

* Please note that weekend work will be required.

What to Expect

Residents should expect some noise, vibration, dust, and site lighting. Work crews will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents, including but not limited to the following:

- No idling of non-essential equipment to reduce the accumulation of construction noise.
- Pointing lights away from residential windows.
- Noise vibration monitoring will be set up to ensure that noise levels are within exposure limits. Wherever possible, high disturbance work will be scheduled during daytime hours.

HOURS OF WORK

- Preparatory work includes both day and night shift, five (5) days per week (Sunday evening to Friday evening)
- Weekend work will be restricted to the weekends identified in the table above and includes both day and night shift (Friday morning to Monday evening)
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- The rail corridor will be accessed through access roads shown on the map. There will not be any construction staging on the access roads.
- Minimal traffic impacts are anticipated.
- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- Pedestrians will not be impacted at this time.
- TTC will not be impacted at this time.
- GO transit will operate on a reduced service schedule during the weekends of November 11-14, 2022 and November 25-28, 2022.

PROJECT INFORMATION

- We're making improvements today to bring you even more service in the future. Preparatory early works are underway on the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor Expansion project in Toronto. This project covers the area between Pape Avenue and Kennedy Road. Completing this work will enable the future addition of a fourth track and electrification infrastructure on the Lakeshore East line.
- Electrification is a key part of building a quieter, faster, more efficient network across the region. The new fourth track will improve journey times for all transit trips on the Lakeshore East Corridor, improve reliability and deliver more service within the City of Toronto.
