


# Lakeshore East Early Works: Construction Notice

December, 2021 – June, 2023



## What Work Is Taking Place?

Dufferin Construction Company along with our key subcontractor will begin construction along the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor from Kennedy Road to Wolcott Avenue.

Construction activities include clearing and grubbing, tree removals, excavation, grading, retaining wall, fence, electrical, subsurface drainage, and restoration.

Crews will work along the north side of the rail corridor within the Metrolinx Right-of-Way, beginning as soon as December 2021, and construction activities will occur primarily at night.

This project will enable the future track construction for improved service along the Lakeshore Corridor.

## What to Expect?

Construction will take place in multiple stages, indicated below, with some overlap of activities. As the rail corridor is lower than the surrounding land, a retaining wall needs to be installed to hold the earth away from the track. Residents will see construction equipment within the rail corridor, including an excavator, dozer, roller, dump/rock truck, drill rigs and concrete trucks. Residents should expect some noise, vibration, dust and site lighting.

Investigative Works	Locate and protection of existing track infrastructure	2 weeks
Vegetation Removal	Removal of trees and vegetation to install the retaining wall	1 months
Access Road	Remove earth and place granular base for access road	2 months
Pile Digging	Digging and filling holes for the retaining wall support beams	7 months
Lagging wall installation	Installing the retaining wall slats to hold back the earth and remove excess earth	4 months
Electrical	Install electrical conducts and grounding	3 months
Grading & Drainage	Place granular base for future track and install subsurface drainage	3 months
Restoration	Seeding and planting	1 month

### Hours of work

Work for construction activities within the railway corridor will occur as follows:

- Work will occur nightly between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., five (5) days per week (Monday night to Saturday morning)
- For safety, work is required to be conducted at night when trains are not running due to the rail corridor being active during daytime hours.
- Please note that work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

### Traffic & pedestrian details

- Traffic and pedestrian impacts are not anticipated with this work.
- Increased construction vehicles and trucks can be expected in the work area.
- Where impacts are expected, notice will be provided through our weekly regional e-newsletter.
