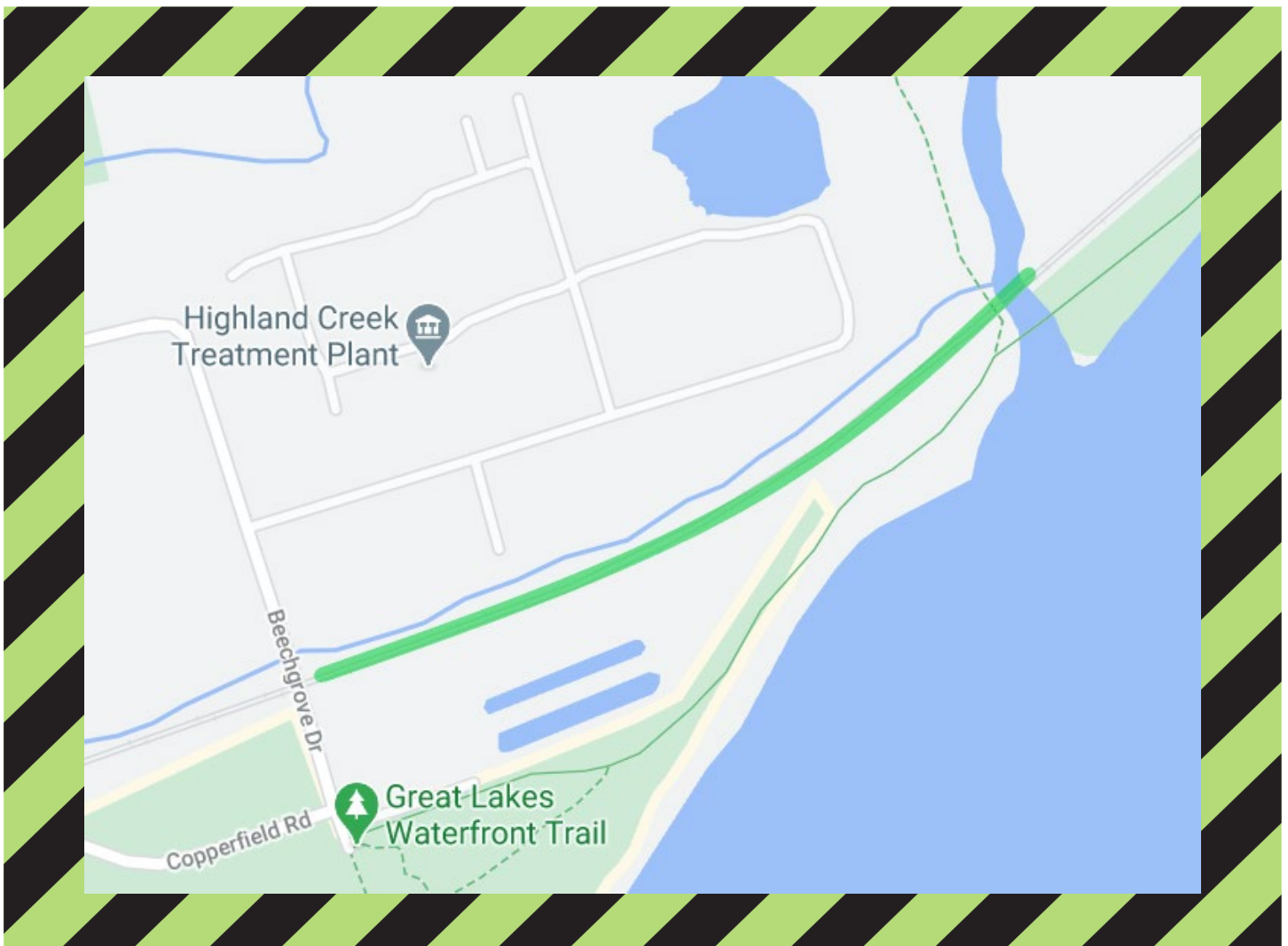


Beechgrove Drive and Highland Creek Bridge Night Work

November 19, 2020



What is Happening?

Starting on Monday November 23 to mid-December 2020 overnight work will be completed between Beechgrove Drive and Highland Creek Bridge, on the south side of the rail corridor – with Beechgrove being the main access point to the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor. There will be no work taking place east of Highland Creek Bridge.

What to Expect

This work involves exposing and relocating fiber optic cables. During this work, residents can expect to see construction equipment and vehicles in the area, including a hydro vacuum truck, backhoes, pick-up trucks and general civil construction equipment.

HOURS OF WORK

- 12:00 a.m.-6:00 a.m. five (5) days per week (Monday-Friday).
- Occasional weekend work may be required.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Minimal traffic impacts are anticipated with this work; increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area(s).
- No pedestrian impacts are anticipated with this work

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No impacts to TTC, or other public transit modes are anticipated during this work.

OTHER INFORMATION

- Rouge Hill GO Station may be used as an access to the corridor and a construction laydown area.
- Crews will endeavor to minimize construction related impacts whenever possible.
- Due to the nature of this work noise, vibration, dust and site lighting can be expected throughout this project.
