



Canadian Navigable Waters Act - Public Notice

Metrolinx hereby gives notice that an application has been made to the Minister of Transport, pursuant to the Canadian Navigable Waters Act for approval of the work described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of the said Act, Metrolinx has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Search registry (<https://cps.canada.ca/>) and under NPP File Number **2019-400128**, a description of the following work, its site and plans:

Existing Highland Creek Rail Bridge expansion to the south to accommodate a third track on the bridge in, on, over, through or across Highland Creek at Mile 318.50 of the Metrolinx Lakeshore East Rail Corridor, Kingston Subdivision in the City of Toronto in front of Lot number 3 Concession D, geographic Township of Scarborough in East Point Park and Port Union Waterfront Park.
