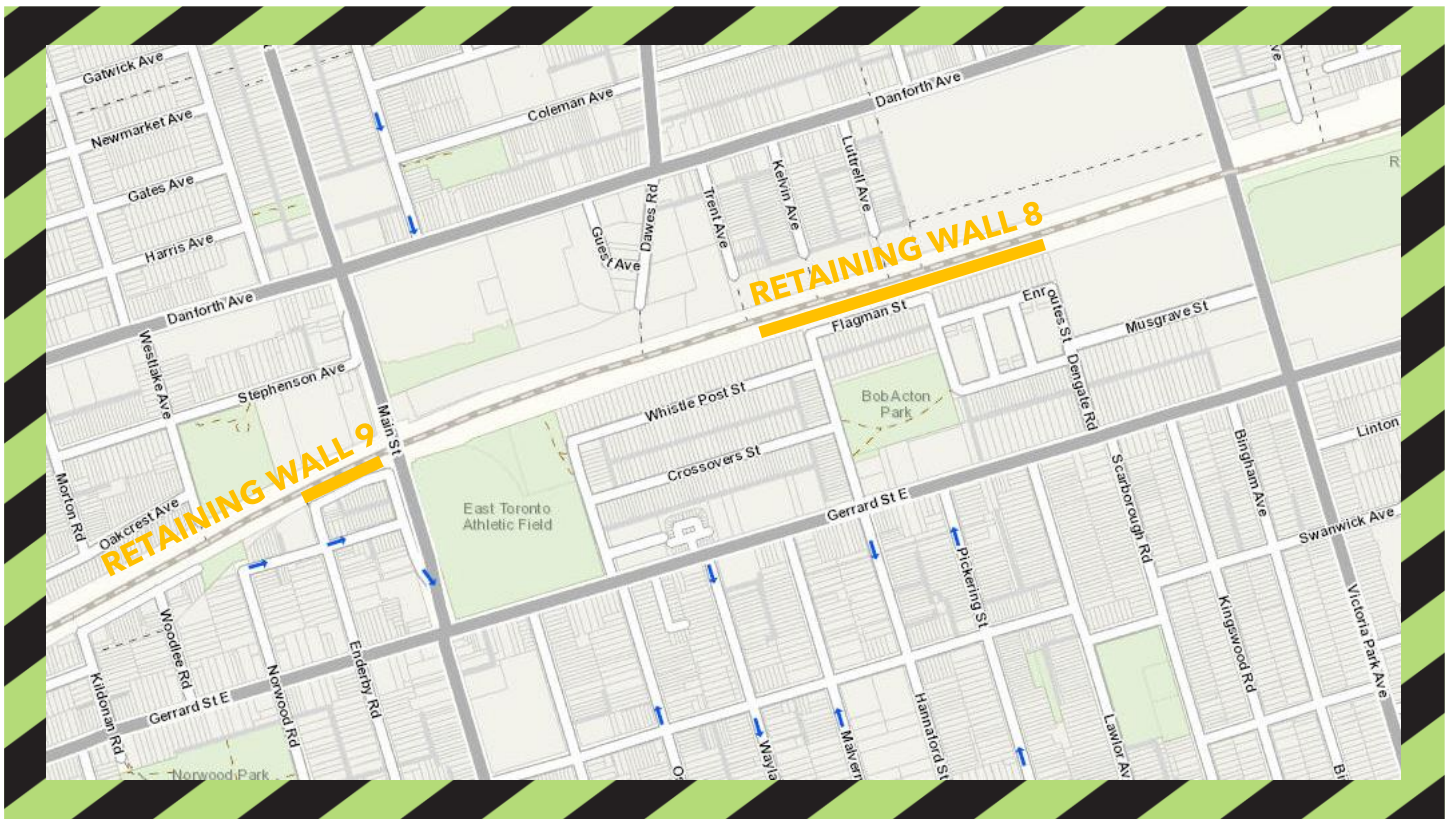


Lakeshore East Early Works: Retaining Walls

What Work Is Taking Place?

Beginning on April 29, 2021, Metrolinx contractors will be constructing two retaining walls along the south side of the rail corridor within the Metrolinx Right-of-Way, between Norwood Road and Victoria Park Avenue.

- Retaining Wall 8 is approximately 520 meters long, runs from east of Ted Reeve Drive to Dengate Road and will be completed by February 2022.
- Retaining Wall 9 is approximately 90 meters long, runs along Little York Road from Enderby Road to Main Street and will be completed by June 2021

What to Expect?

These retaining walls are made up of steel piles drilled into the earth and backfilled with concrete to ground elevation. Pre-cast concrete panels are placed between the steel piles above ground level. Residents will see construction equipment within the rail corridor, including an excavator, dozer, dump truck, drilling rig and concrete trucks. Residents should expect some noise, vibration, dust and site lighting.

HOURS OF WORK

Work at Retaining Wall 8 will be conducting during the day.

- Work will occur between the hours of 7:00 am and 5:00 pm, five (5) days per week (Monday to Friday)
- Additional work may be required during the evening hours. Advanced notice will be provided through our weekly regional e-newsletter.
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

Work at Retaining Wall 9 will be conducting during the night.

- Work will occur between the hours of 7:00 pm and 6:00 am, five (5) days per week (Monday to Friday)
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Minimal traffic impacts are anticipated with this work. Where traffic impacts are expected, notice will be provided through our weekly regional e-newsletter.
- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- No pedestrian impacts are anticipated with this work.
