

# Utility Investigative Work - Eastwood Avenue

May 4, 2021



## What work is taking place?

Utility investigative work will be completed within the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor on Tuesday May 4, 2021. Once onsite, crews will begin excavating test pit(s) on the north side of the corridor using hydro-vacuum excavation to expose existing utilities and structures within the work area. Once completed, the area will be backfilled and restored to its previous condition.

## What to Expect?

The work area shown in yellow on the map is within the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor. Residents can expect to see construction vehicles and equipment staged on Kimridge Avenue on the north side of the corridor, shown in green on the map. Eastwood Avenue, on the south of the corridor will be used by crews to access the rail corridor, this area is reflected in blue on the map. Residents should expect some noise, vibration and dust throughout this work.

### HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur between the hours of 8:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday May 4, 2021.
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

### TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- On the east end of Kimridge Avenue, near Wolcott Avenue traffic will be reduced to one (1) lane only to allow for vehicle and equipment staging.
- There will be flaggers onsite and advanced signage, to safely direct traffic around the area.
- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the area.
- No pedestrian impacts are anticipated with this work.

### TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No impacts to TTC or other public transit modes are anticipated during this work.
- This work is not anticipated to impact Lakeshore East GO service.

### PROJECT INFORMATION

- We're making improvements today to bring you even more service in the future. Preparatory early works are getting underway on the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor Expansion project in Toronto. This project covers the area between Pape Avenue and Kennedy Road. Completing this work will enable the future addition of a fourth track and electrification infrastructure on the Lakeshore East line.
- Electrification is a key part of building a quieter, faster, more efficient network across the region. The new fourth track will improve journey times for all transit trips on the Lakeshore East Corridor, improve reliability and deliver more service within the City of Toronto.
