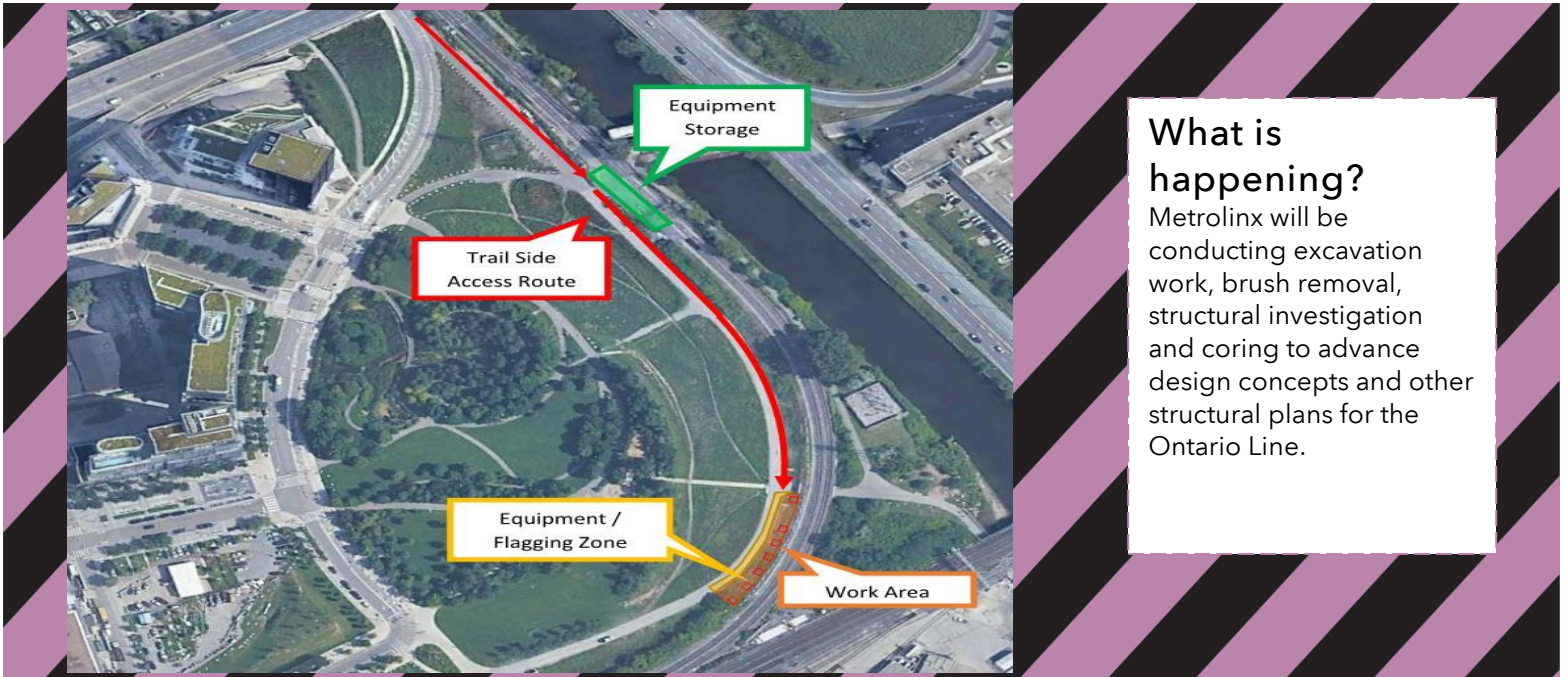


Early Works for Southern Section of Corktown Commons Park

Starting as early as August 11th 2022



What is happening?
 Metrolinx will be conducting excavation work, brush removal, structural investigation and coring to advance design concepts and other structural plans for the Ontario Line.



Timing

- **Scheduled start:** August 11th, 2022
- **Duration:** Three Days
- **Days:** M-F
- **Hours:** 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.



What to expect

- Crews will be conducting pre-construction activities in the southern portion of Corktown Commons (including the lower Don trail) including but not limited to:
 - **Brush Removal**
 - **Excavation**
 - **Structural investigation & Coring**
- **Brush Removal** - crews will remove the vegetation at the 7 proposed pit locations within the work area to allow the excavator and crew to access the wall and foundation.
- **Excavation** - crews will excavate one pit at a time near the structural wall at 7 locations within the work area in order for staff to scan the wall and foundation; once scans are complete, crews will backfill the pits.
- **Structural Investigation and Coring** - crews will enter the excavated zone to conduct non-destructive scans to confirm reinforcement locations and then take concrete cores to evaluate the capacity of the structure.
- To facilitate this work, a partial closure of the lower Don trail is required. Half the trail will be open for users. Flaggers will be on the trail to redirect users and pylons with signage will inform users of construction.
- Please take care when riding a bike/walking near construction areas. Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians, as detours may be required.
- Work will generate minimal noise that will not be disruptive to residents.
- Equipment maybe left on site after work is completed each day.
- There will not be any impacts on traffic or transit.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or any unforeseen circumstances.
