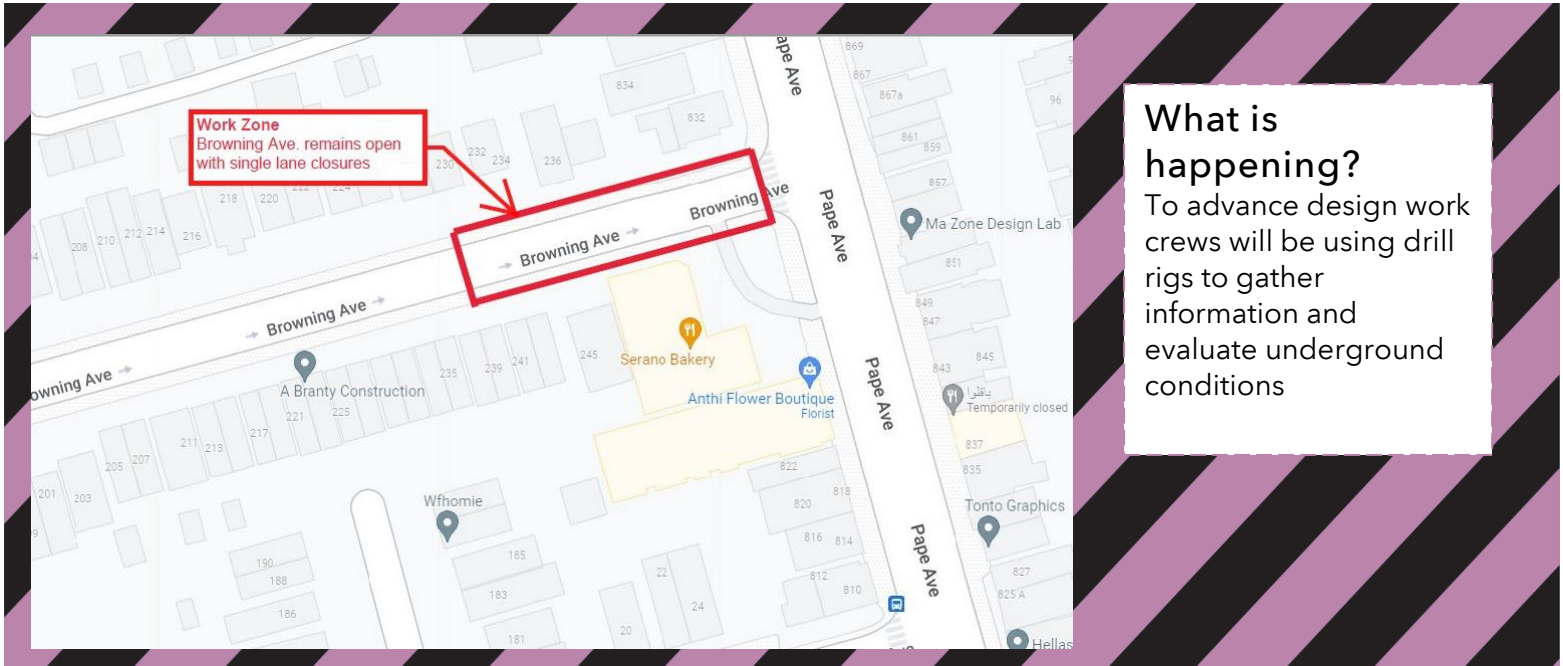


Geotechnical Drilling along Browning Ave. near Pape Ave.

Starting as early as August 22nd 2022



What is happening?
 To advance design work crews will be using drill rigs to gather information and evaluate underground conditions



Timing

- Scheduled start: August 22nd, 2022
- Duration: Approximately 2 months
- Days: Mondays to Fridays
- Hours: Approx. 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.



What to expect

- Crews will use a drill rig and support trucks to conduct geotechnical drilling along Browning Ave.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by a drill rig and other construction equipment related to this work. Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Closure of 3 parking spaces 24 hours a day, 7 days a week between Serona Bakery Parking Lot and driveway of 245 Browning Ave (south curb line).
- Drums to be left on site surrounded by a fence when drilling is underway. Equipment will be left overnight and fenced in.
- Only traffic on Browning Ave. will be impacted. Only one of two lanes on the one-lane road will be impacted at any one time. All sidewalks will remain open and accessible.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or any unforeseen circumstances.
