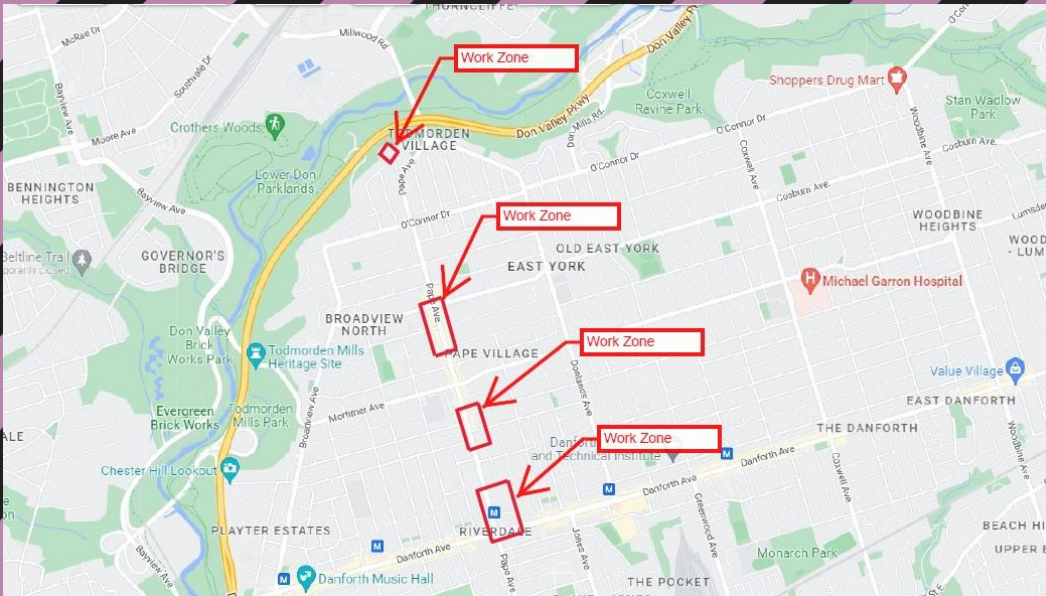


# Geotechnical Work Continues Pape Ave from Hopedale Ave to Danforth Ave Extended until December 2022



**What is happening?**  
To advance design work of the Ontario Line, crews will be using drill machines to gather information and evaluate underground conditions.



## Timing

- **Scheduled End:** Approximately December 2022
- **Day(s):** Monday to Friday
- **Hours:** 9:00am to 4:00pm



## What to expect

- Crews will use a drill rig and support trucks to conduct work.
- Drums will be removed from site at the end of work on each test pit.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by drilling and other construction equipment related to this work. Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Please take care and watch for signs directing pedestrians when walking near construction areas. One lane is expected to be closed to facilitate work at any given time throughout the period.
- A Paid Duty Officer and a flag person will be onsite to ensure traffic is maintained in all directions. There are no impacts to sidewalks.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
