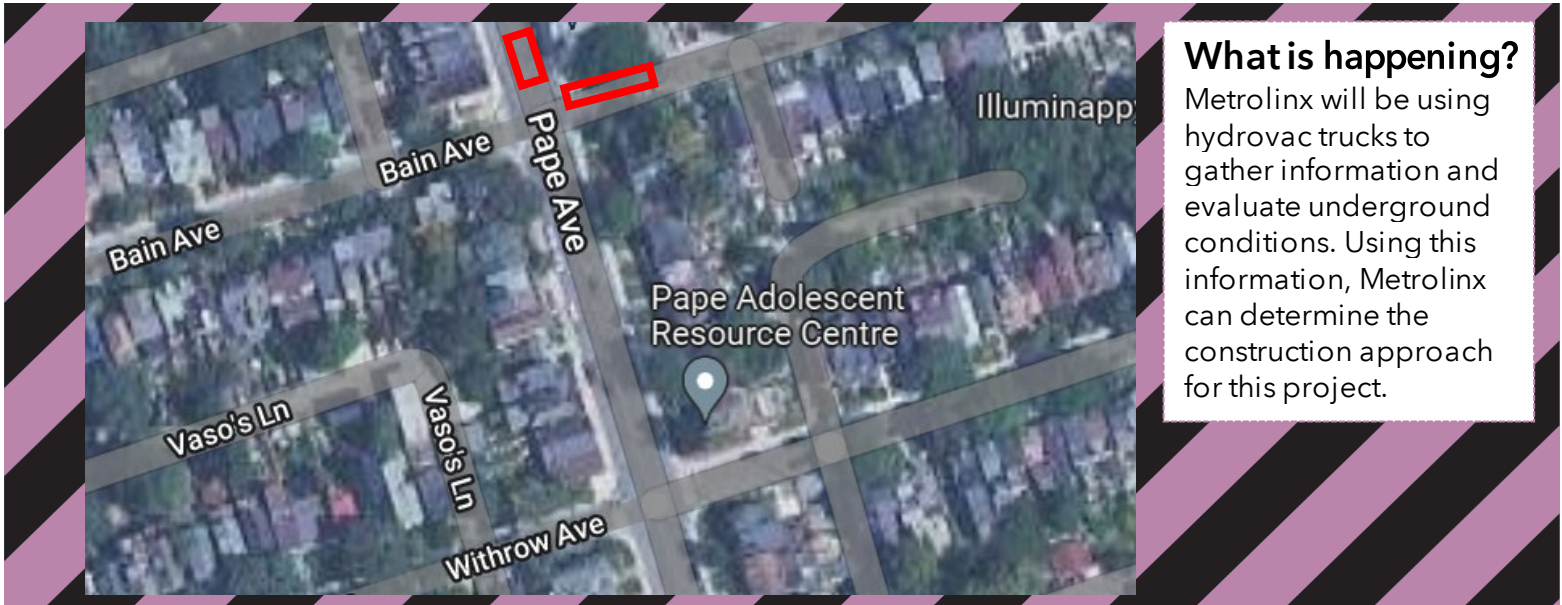


Hydrovac test pits at the intersection of Pape Avenue and Bain Avenue

Starting as early as October 24th, 2022



What is happening?
 Metrolinx will be using hydrovac trucks to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, Metrolinx can determine the construction approach for this project.

Timing


- **Scheduled start:** October 24, 2022
- **Duration:** Five (5) days
- **Days:** Monday-Friday
- **Hours:** 9am to 3pm

What to expect

- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks and other construction equipment.
- There will always be one lane open on the side of traffic they are working on.
- To identify locates, there will be some paint markings and staking. Pylons and barricades will be set up to provide barriers between pedestrians and cyclists, and traffic.
- The crew will do their best to keep the dust impact low by adding water when performing saw cuts.
- A paid duty officer will be on site to redirect traffic.
- Equipment will be cleared at the end of every shift.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.
