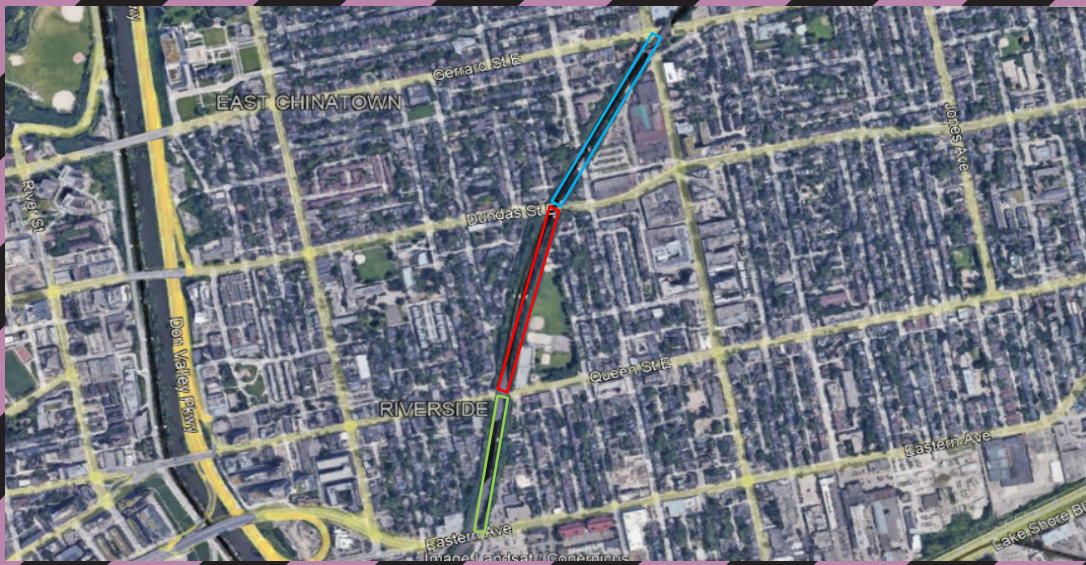


Overnight investigative drilling work in the rail corridor from Carlaw Avenue to Eastern Avenue

Starting as early as Nov 08, 2021



What is happening?
 Metrolinx will be using small drill rigs and trucks to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, Metrolinx can begin to determine the construction approach for this project.



Timing



- **Scheduled start:** Nov 08, 2021
- **Duration:**
Blue - Nov 08 to Nov 19 (10 Nights)
Red - Nov 15 to Nov 19 (4 Nights)
Green - Nov 17 to Nov 23 (5 Nights)
- **Days:** Monday-Friday
- **Hours:** 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

What to expect

- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and lights caused by a drill rig, trucks and other construction equipment.
- Work equipment may be left on-site until work is completed.
- Periodic short duration site visits to conduct sampling will be conducted after drilling concludes. There will be no noise, traffic, parking or pedestrian impacts associated with this work.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
