

# Investigative drilling work at the intersection of Muriel Ave. and Gertrude Place

**What is happening?**

MetroInx will be using drill rigs and trucks to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, MetroInx can determine the construction approach for this project.

## What to expect

- The work crew will be drilling one (1) borehole at the intersection of Muriel Ave. and Gertrude Place.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by a drill rig, trucks and other construction equipment related to this work.
- No sidewalk or bike lane closures are expected during this drilling work.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
