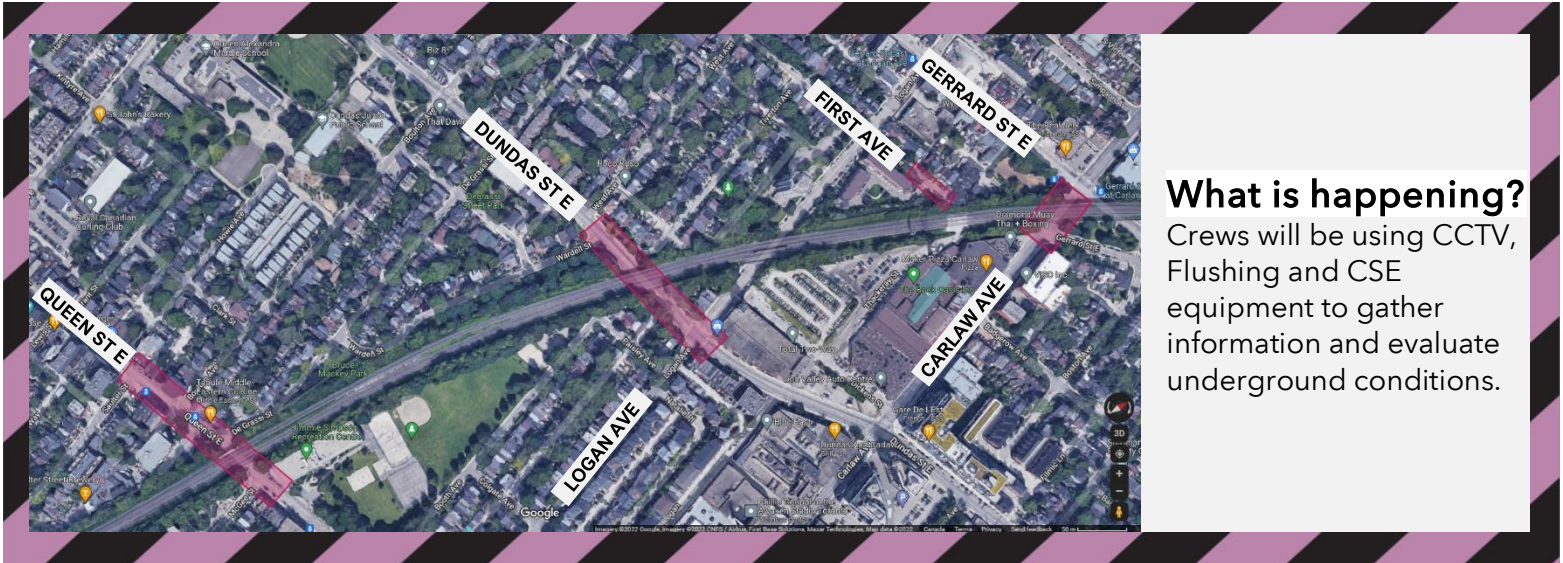


OVERNIGHT / DAYTIME SEWER INVESTIGATION WORK BETWEEN QUEEN ST. E. AND GERRARD ST. E.

Starting as early as March 28, 2022



Timing

3-4 shifts from 9pm to 6am

Daytime

1-2 shifts from 9am to 5pm

What to expect

- Work is scheduled from **March 28, 2022, until April 4, 2022.**
- Most of CCTV, Flushing, and Confined Space Entry (CSE) Work will occur between 9pm and 6am from Monday to Friday. Several shifts may be required for Flushing and CSE work from 9am to 5pm.
- Crew of two people will be opening manholes and catch basins to clean them with flush truck and collect accurate data on pipes. CCTV crew will use robotic equipment to record pipe conditions. Another crew uses surveying equipment to take measurements of the utility locations.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, including vacuum trucks and other equipment related to this work.
- Crews will avoid entering private property to the extent possible and will work from municipal plans. Access to properties will be maintained at all times through at least one driveway.
