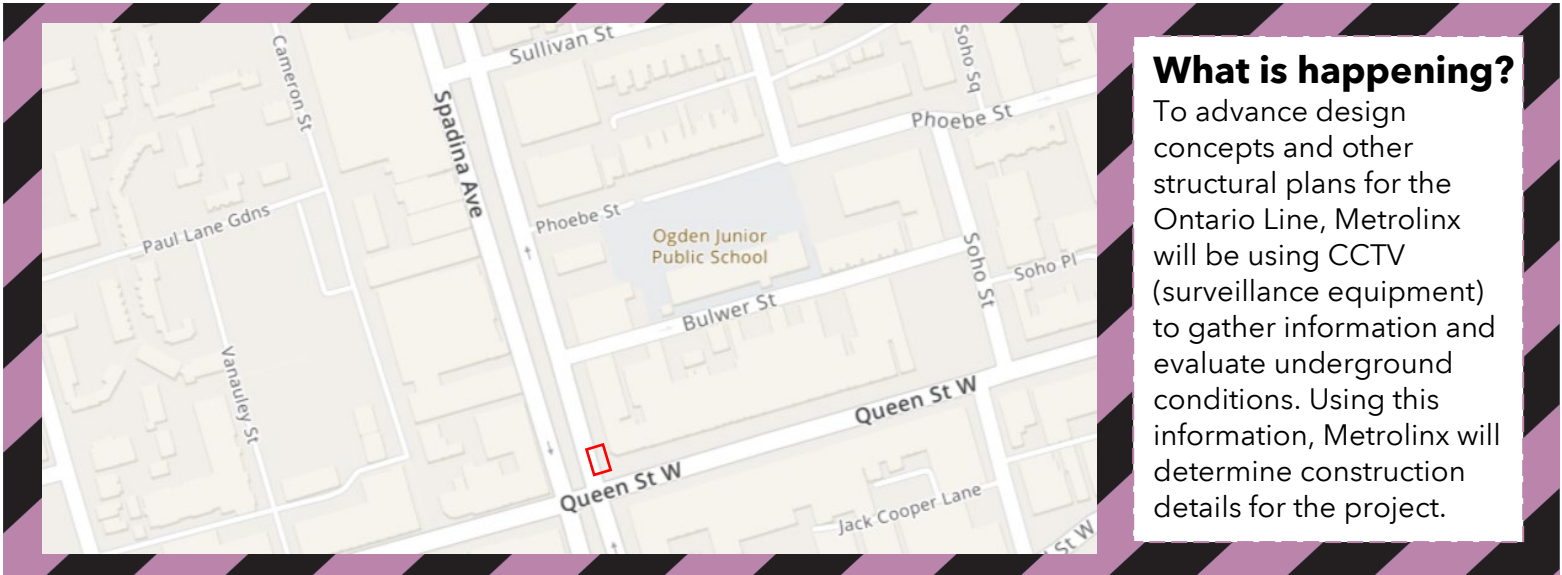


# Overnight CCTV investigative work on Spadina Avenue near Queen Street West

Starting as early as January 30, 2022



**What is happening?**  
 To advance design concepts and other structural plans for the Ontario Line, Metrolinx will be using CCTV (surveillance equipment) to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, Metrolinx will determine construction details for the project.



## Timing



- **Scheduled start:** January 30, 2022
- **Duration:** One day
- **Days:** Sunday
- **Hours:** 8 p.m.-3 a.m.

## What to expect

- Crews will use handheld CCTV (surveillance equipment) to investigate underground conditions through a manhole. **No noise is expected from this work.**
- During work hours, the northbound curb lane will be occupied. A paid duty police officer will be on-site to assist with traffic control. Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- No impacts to the sidewalk or pedestrian access are expected.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
