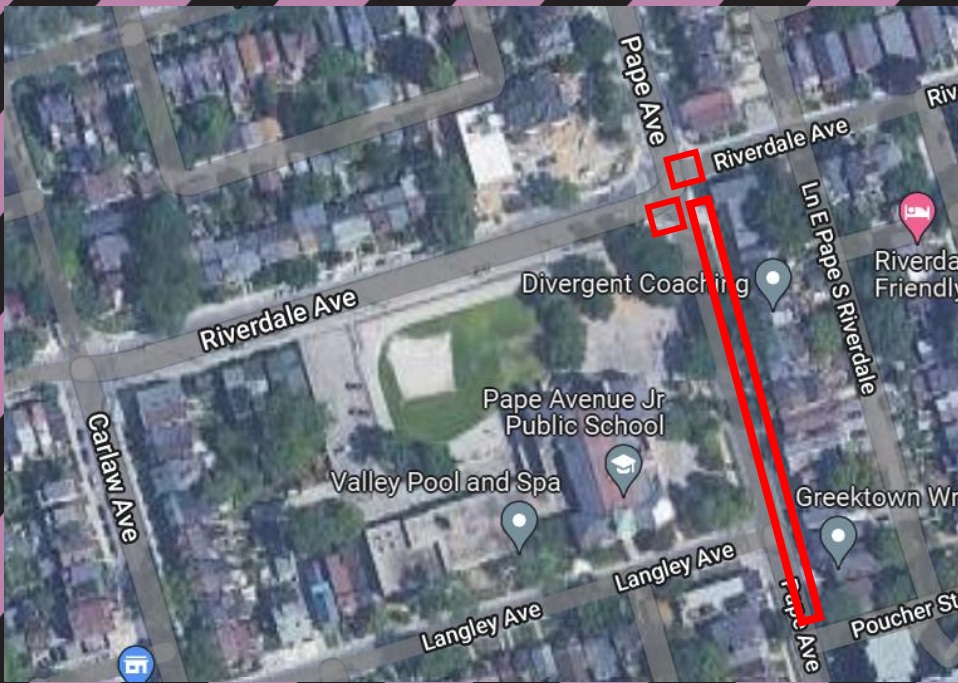


Hydrovac work along Pape Ave in the vicinity of the Pape-Riverdale intersection

Starting as early as October 26th, 2022



What is happening?
 Metrolinx will be using hydrovac trucks to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, Metrolinx can determine the construction approach for this project.



Timing



- **Scheduled start:** October 26, 2022
- **Duration:** Five (5) days
- **Days:** Wednesday-Tuesday
- **Hours:** 9am to 3pm

What to expect

- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks and other construction equipment.
- Crew will always maintain one lane of traffic throughout the duration of the work.
- To identify locates, there will be some paint markings and staking. Pylons and barricades will be set up to provide barriers between pedestrians and cyclists, and traffic.
- The crew will do their best to keep the dust impact low by adding water when performing saw cuts.
- All work-related equipment will be removed at the end of each day.
- A paid duty officer will be on site to redirect traffic.
- Equipment will be cleared at the end of every shift.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
