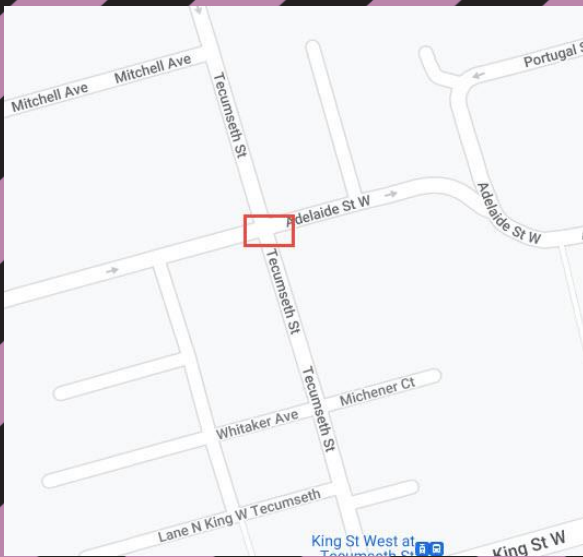


Investigative overnight hydrovac work at Adelaide St W and Tecumseth St

Starting as early as September 7, 2022



What is happening?
 To confirm locations of all nearby utilities for the Ontario Line, Metrolinx will be using a vacuum truck to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, Metrolinx will determine construction details for the project.



Timing



- **Scheduled start:** September 7, 2022
- **Duration:** Two nights
- **Days:** Overnight
- **Hours:** 9 p.m. - 5 a.m.

What to expect

- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks and other equipment related to this work. Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- The right lane on Tecumseth St northbound will be closed approaching Adelaide St W for the duration of the work.
- Pylons and barricades will be in place to redirect pedestrians and cyclists during work hours. A police officer will be on-site to direct pedestrian and cyclist traffic.
- Work equipment will not be left on-site outside working hours.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
