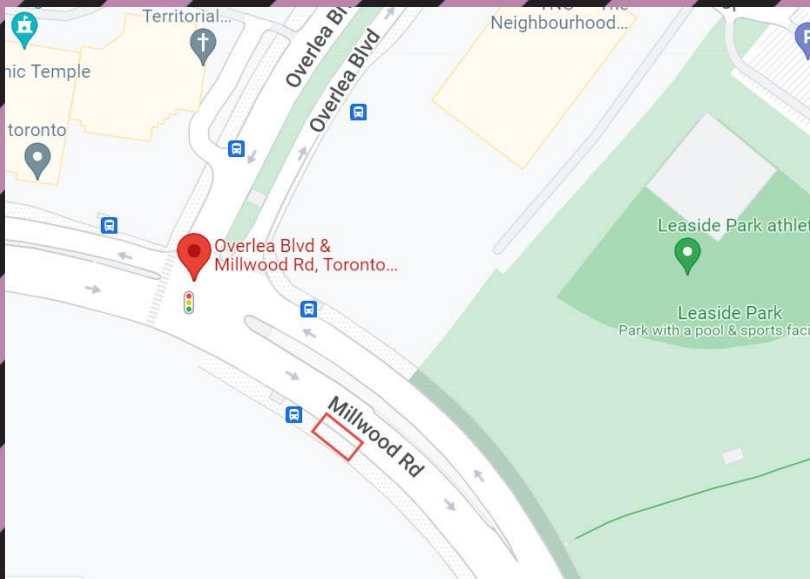


# Investigative drilling work along Millwood Road near Overlea Blvd

Starting as early as November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022



## What is happening?

To advance design concepts and other structural plans for the Ontario Line, Metrolinx will be drilling test holes and using a vacuum truck to gather information and evaluate underground conditions.

## What to expect

- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks and other equipment related to this work. Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- There will be impacts on traffic, bicycle, and pedestrian traffic, however, this will be mitigated by traffic pylons and barricades.
- Spray paint and stakes will be used to mark the locations of underground utilities.
- There will be a lane closure required for the side of the street on which the work is being done.
- A paid duty officer on-site to assist with directing traffic.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
