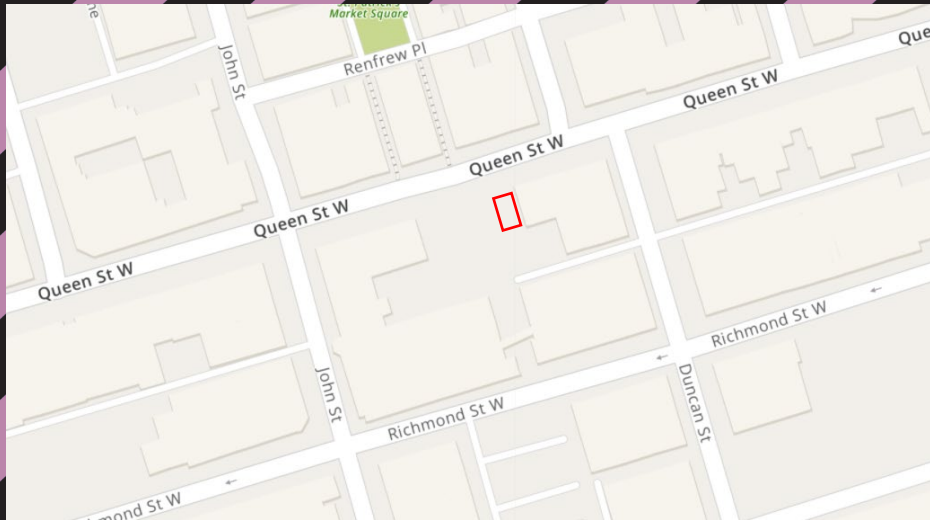


Investigative drilling work in the Bell Media parking lot at 299 Queen Street West

Starting as early as February 7, 2022



What is happening?

MetroLinx will be using small drill rigs and trucks to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, MetroLinx can begin to determine the construction approach for this project.



Timing

- **Scheduled start:** February 7, 2022
- **Duration:** Up to three weeks
- **Days:** Monday-Friday
- **Hours:** 9 a.m.-6 p.m.



What to expect

- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by a drill rig, trucks and other construction equipment related to this work.
- Periodic short-duration site visits to monitor groundwater conditions will be conducted after drilling concludes. There will be no noise, traffic or pedestrian impacts associated with this follow-up work.
- Please take care and watch for signs directing pedestrians when walking near construction areas. Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Work equipment may be left on-site until work is completed.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
