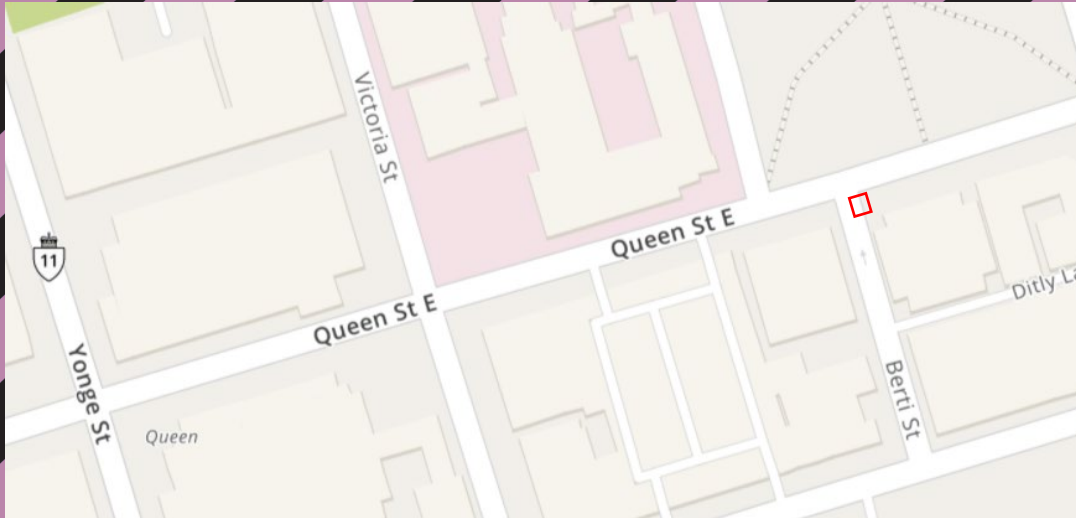


Investigative drilling work on Berti Street near Queen Street East

Starting as early as October 1, 2021



What is happening?

Metrolinx will be using small drill rigs and trucks to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, Metrolinx can begin to determine the construction approach for this project.



Timing

- **Scheduled start:** October 1, 2021
- **Duration:** Up to four weeks
- **Days:** Monday-Friday
- **Hours:** 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m.



What to expect

- During construction hours, some lane closures will be required in the area shown on the map. Some traffic delays are expected.
 - Northbound lane on Berti Street will be occupied.
 - Southbound lane on Berti Street will remain open to traffic.
- A paid duty officer will help direct traffic. Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by a drill rig, trucks and other construction equipment related to this work.
- Work equipment may be left on-site until work is completed.
- Please take care and watch for signs directing pedestrians when walking near construction areas. Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
