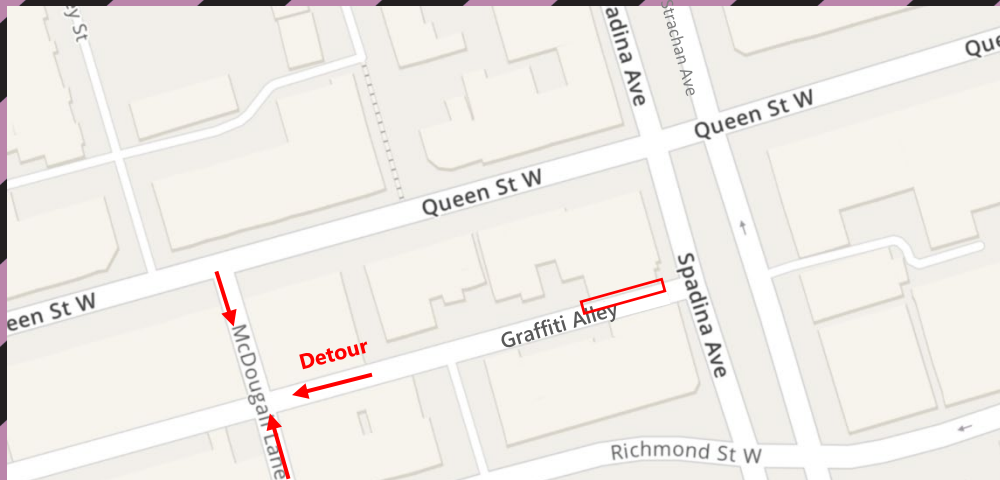


Investigative drilling work on Graffiti Alley

Starting as early as December 15, 2021



What is happening?

To advance design concepts and other structural plans for the Ontario Line, Metrolinx will be using a vacuum truck to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, Metrolinx will determine construction details for the project.



Timing

- **Scheduled start:** December 15, 2021
- **Duration:** Up to four weeks
- **Days:** Monday to Friday
- **Hours:** 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.



What to expect

- There will be no impacts to any existing artwork/murals in this area.
- During work hours, some temporary lane reductions/closure will be required. There will be a detour as shown on the map, and a flag person will be on-site to assist with traffic control.
- Please take care and watch for signs directing pedestrians when walking near construction areas. Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks and other equipment related to this work. Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
