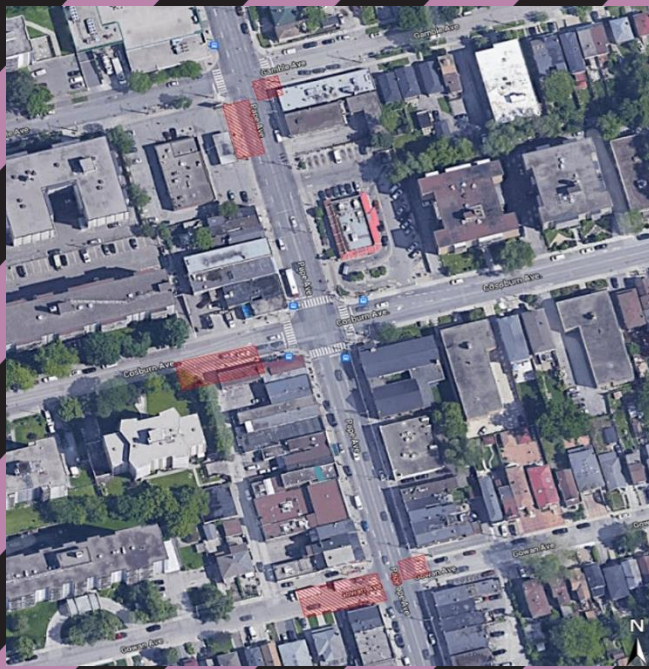


Investigative hydrovac work near Gamble Ave., Cosburn Ave. and Gowan Ave.

Starting as early as April 11, 2022



What is happening?
 To advance design concepts and other structural plans for the Ontario Line, Metrolinx will be drilling test holes and using a vacuum truck to gather information and evaluate underground conditions.

Timing


- **Scheduled start:** April 11, 2022
- **Duration:** Four (4) Days
- **Days:** Monday-Thursday
- **Hours:** 8 a.m.-4 p.m.

What to expect

- To advance design concepts and other structural plans for the Ontario Line, Metrolinx will be drilling test holes and using a vacuum truck to gather information and evaluate underground conditions.
- There will be impacts on traffic, bicycle, and pedestrian traffic, however, this will be mitigated by traffic pylons and barricades.
- There will be a paid duty officer on-site to assist with directing traffic.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks and other equipment related to this work. Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Work equipment may be left on-site until work is completed.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
