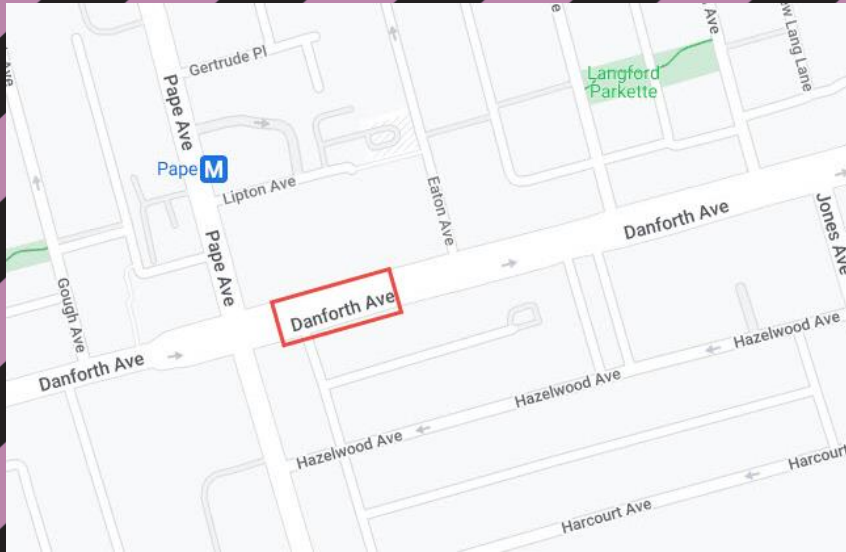


Overnight Investigative drilling work along Danforth Ave between Pape Ave and Eaton Ave.

Starting as early as November 7th 2022



What is happening?

MetroInx will be using drill rigs and trucks to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, MetroInx can determine the construction approach for this project.



Timing

- **Scheduled start:**
November 7, 2022
- **Duration:**
Approximately two (2) nights
- **Day(s):** Monday-Wednesday
- **Hours:** Approximately 9 p.m.-5 a.m.



What to expect

- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks and other construction equipment.
- Lane will be closed due to work- one lane will always be open for traffic on the east or west side depending on which test pit they are working on.
- Equipment will be removed at the end of the work period.
- A Paid Duty Officer will be on site to help direct traffic.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
