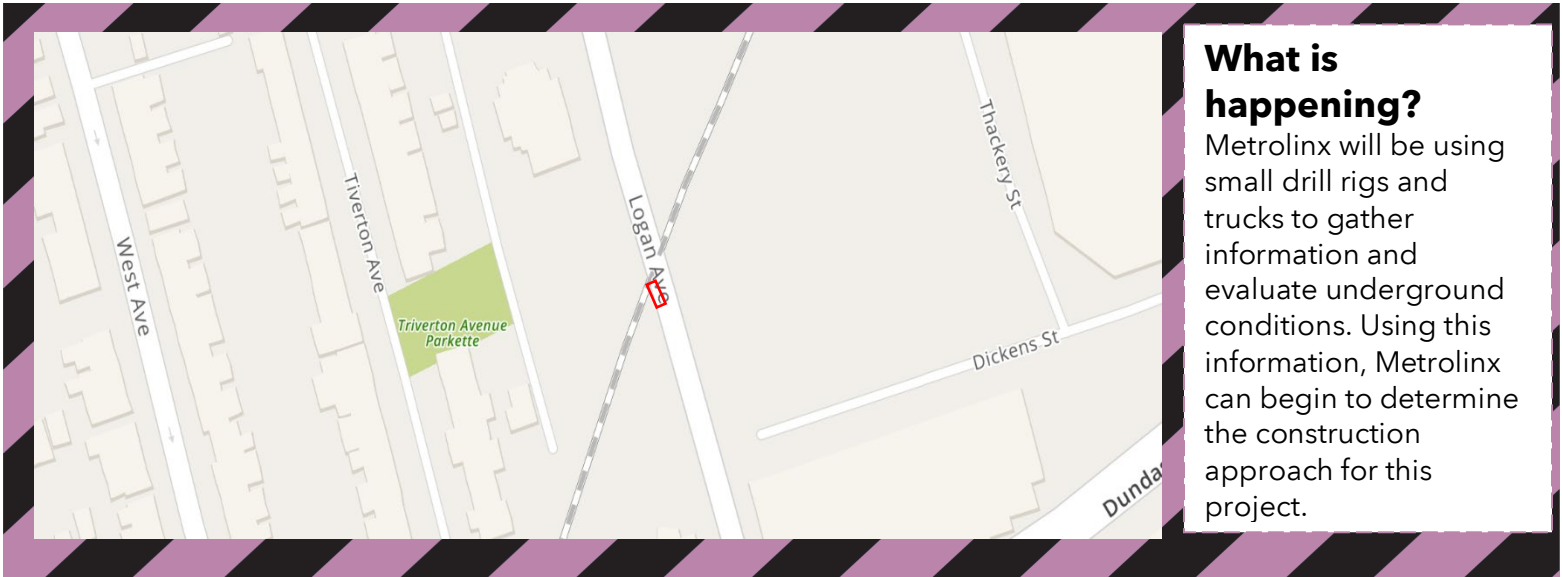


Overnight Investigative drilling work near the Logan Avenue Bridge

Starting as early as October 4, 2021

IMPORTANT: Residents with vehicles parked in the work area need to move their vehicles before 8pm



What is happening?
 MetroInx will be using small drill rigs and trucks to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, MetroInx can begin to determine the construction approach for this project.

Timing


- **Scheduled start:** October 4, 2021 at 9pm
- **Duration:** 8 hours
- **Days:** two nights
- **Hours:** 9:00pm to 5:00am


What to expect

- Some street parking and bike lanes may be inaccessible during work hours in the work areas. **Residents will need to move their cars in the work area before 8 pm.** Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Please take care and watch for signs directing pedestrians when walking near construction areas.
- Residents and businesses near the work site may hear noise caused by a drill rig, trucks and other construction equipment related to this work.
- Work equipment may be left on-site until work is completed.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
