

Overnight investigative hydrovac work on Richmond Street West and Yonge Street

Starting as early as February 2, 2022



What is happening?

To advance design concepts and other structural plans for the Ontario Line, Metrolinx will be using a vacuum truck to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, Metrolinx will determine construction details for the project.



Timing

- **Scheduled start:** February 2, 2022
- **Duration:** Three days
- **Days:** Wednesday-Friday
- **Hours:** 9 p.m.-6 a.m.



What to expect

- During work hours, some temporary lane reductions will be required. On Richmond Street West, the curb lane on the south side will be occupied in two locations, just east of Bay Street and west of Yonge Street. On Yonge Street, the curb lane on the west side (north of Richmond) and the curb lane on the east side (south of Richmond) will be occupied. There will be a traffic control person on-site to assist with directing traffic.
- Spray paint and stakes will be used to mark the locations of underground utilities.
- There are no impacts to the sidewalk or pedestrian access.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks and other equipment related to this work. Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Work equipment may be left on-site until work is completed.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
