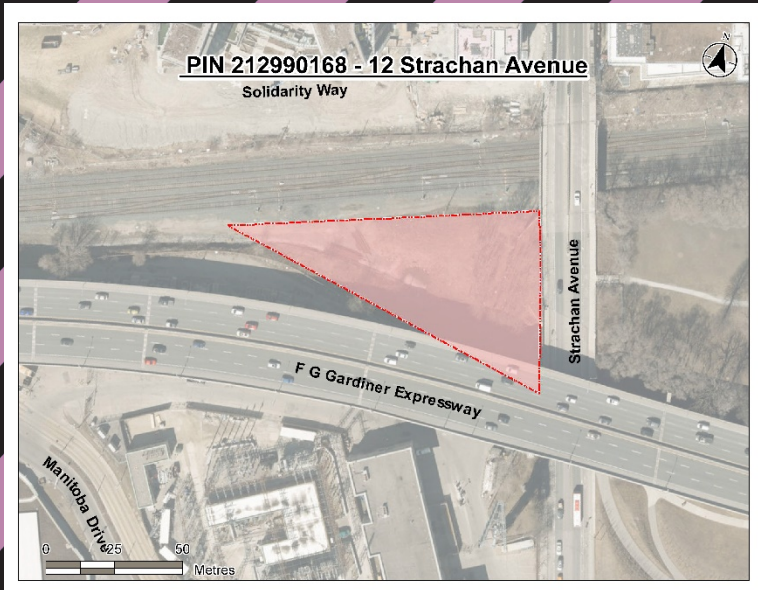


Pre-Construction Activities at Fort York (12 Strachan)

Starting as early as June 13, 2022



What is happening?
 Metrolinx will be conducting various pre-construction activities in the Fort York area to prepare the site for the future construction of a power supply station that will support the Ontario Line.

Timing



What to expect

- **Scheduled start:** June 13, 2022.
- **Duration:**
 - **Pre-construction and heritage survey, and DSS work** - one day
 - **Tree and SAR work** may occur on a separate date than the pre-construction, heritage and DSS work - one to three days (depending on if SAR are observed)
- **Hours:** 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

- Crews will be conducting ongoing work around Fort York including but not limited to:
 - Pre-construction and heritage survey
 - Designated Substances Survey (DSS)
 - Tree and Species at Risk (SAR) Survey
- **Pre-construction and heritage survey:** The intent is to identify the general condition of the site before the commencement of any potential demolition, preservation, or modification activities. A heritage survey will be completed at the same time to document any observed heritage attributes on the property.
- **Designated Substances Survey (DSS):** The purpose of this work is to identify any designated substances and hazardous materials prior to their disturbance. The work will be conducted by two (2) work crew members who will use a camera and handheld tools to collect samples of materials located on the surface of the property.
- **Tree and Species at Risk (SAR) Survey:** Prior to removal of any vegetation, a SAR assessment is required. If bat roosts are observed, the SAR

assessment will include acoustic monitoring of bat roosts. This work is non-invasive and will take one to three days to complete. A tree survey will be completed by a qualified arborist to develop a tree inventory of the site prior to project activities.
