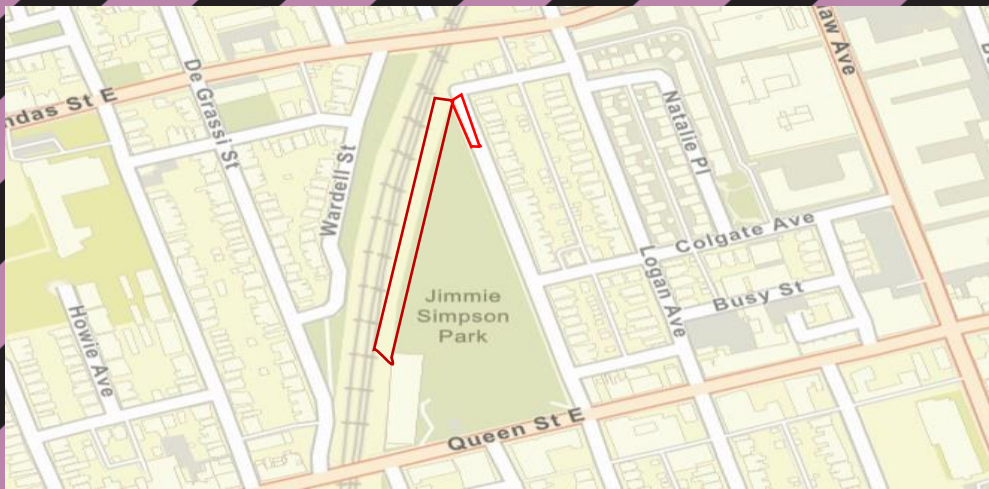


# Investigative Daylighting work in the rail corridor and Jimmie Simpson Park from Paisley Avenue to Queen Street East.

Starting as early as March 28, 2022



**What is happening?**  
 Metrolinx will be using HydroVac Truck in Jimmie Simpson Park to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, Metrolinx can begin to determine the construction approach for this project.

## Timing


- **Scheduled start:** Mar 28, 2022
- **Duration:** 1 week
- **Days:** Monday-Friday (Day Shift)
- **Hours:** 8:00 a.m. to 5 p.m.

## What to expect

- The HydroVac Truck will be parked on the West side of Booth Avenue (highlighted in red) near 305 Booth Ave and 293 Booth Ave. This will not impact cars parked on the East side of Booth Ave.
- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks and other construction equipment.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
