

Overnight investigative work in the Metrolinx rail corridor from Carlaw Avenue to Thackeray Street

Starting as early as March 20, 2022



What is happening?
 Contractors will be using small drill rigs and trucks within the rail corridor to gather information and evaluate underground conditions.

Timing

- **Scheduled start:** Mar 20, 2022
- **Duration:** 3 Nights
- **Days:** Sunday-Tuesday (Night Shift)
- **Hours:** 11:45 pm to 6 am


What to expect

- In order to maintain daytime rail operations and safety, crews will be working overnight along the rail corridor.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect some noise caused by small drill rigs and lights by trucks and other construction equipment. However, every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Periodic short duration site visits to conduct sampling will be conducted after drilling concludes.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
