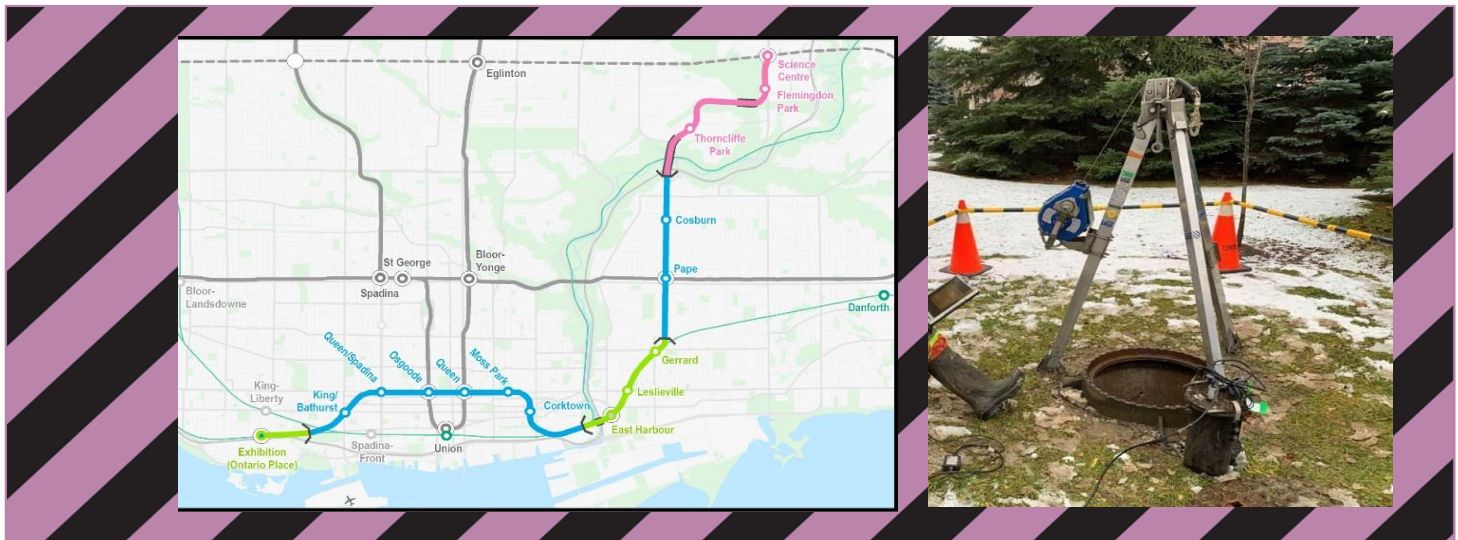


Maintenance and verification of sewage system monitors along the Ontario Line

Starting as early as July 18, 2022



Timing

- **Scheduled start:** July 18th 2022
- **Duration:** One day
- **Hours:** 8 am to 5 pm
- **Locations:** See below
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or any unforeseen circumstances.

What to expect


- To advance design concepts and other structural plans for the Ontario Line, Metrolinx installed sewage system monitors at locations along the Ontario Line, in order to understand how the sewer system behaves during wet weather. Using this information, Metrolinx can determine the optimal construction approach for this project.
- Verification work and maintenance on the monitors will be taking place around manholes and underground in the sewage system.
- During work hours, some lane reductions may be required, and traffic will be diverted. Paid duty police officers will assist with traffic control.
- Please take care when walking near construction areas. Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians, as detours may be required.
