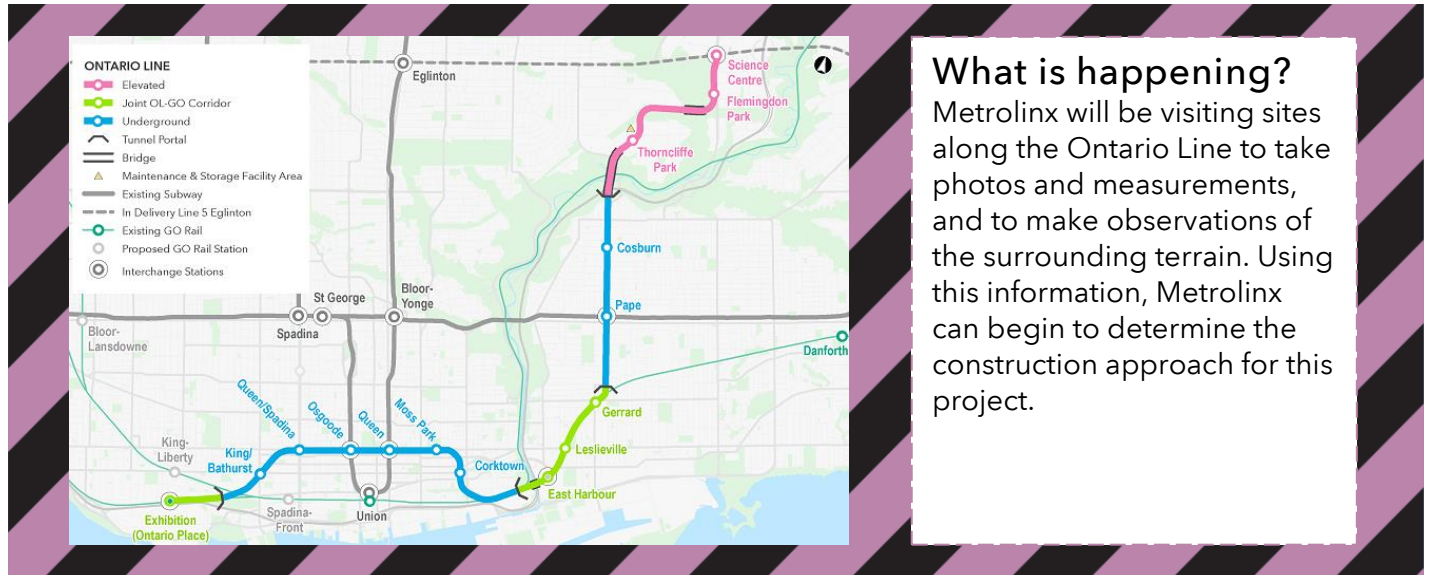


# Site visits along the Ontario Line



## Timing

- **Duration:** Work is continuing until the end of this year.
- **Days:** Monday-Friday
- **Hours:** 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.

## What to expect

- Crews will visit various sites along the Ontario Line route to make observations and take notes, using hand-held equipment to take measurements and photos of the terrain.
- This work does not involve noise or paint markings.
- Most site visits will take place in public spaces and public rights-of-way. Crews will avoid entering private property to the extent possible and will work from municipal plans. If entry onto private property is needed, property owners will be notified separately. Access to properties will be maintained at all times through at least one driveway.
- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions and expedite work.
- Work may be delayed or reschedule due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
