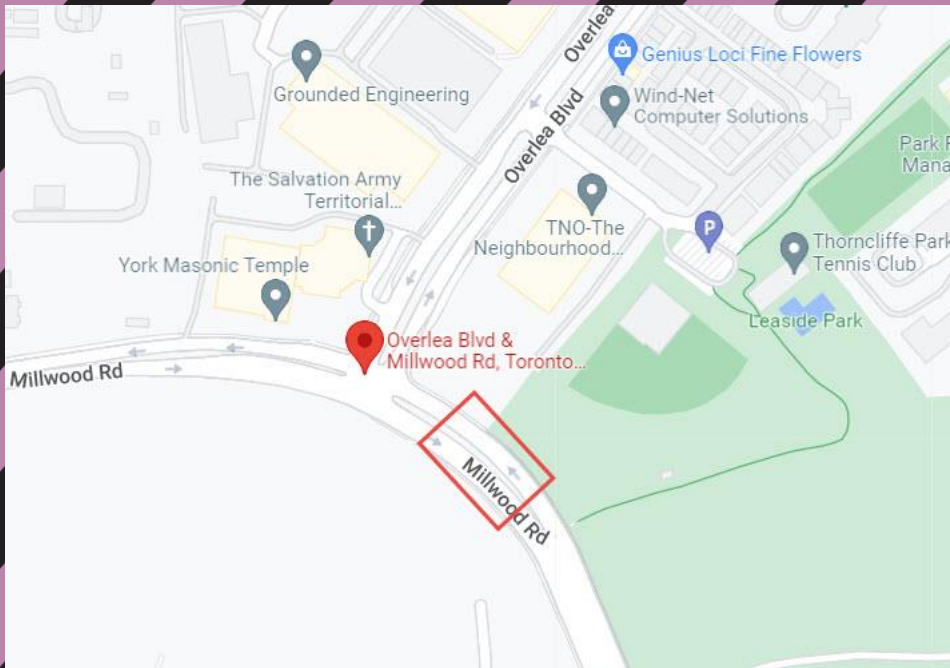


Surveying work on Millwood Rd south of Overlea Blvd

Starting as early as July 5, 2022



What is happening?
 Metrolinx will be surveying areas along the Ontario Line to identify utility locations, take measurements and evaluate underground conditions.

Timing

What to expect

- A two or three-person crew will use monitoring and measuring equipment to locate utilities in the field.
- Paint markings and staking will be used on the ground to note physical location of underground utilities.
- Utilities are located within the public right of way. The limits of the road or sidewalk do not always match up with the limits of the public right of way. At times, utility location markings will be visible on sidewalks, driveways and front lawns.
- Crews will avoid entering private property to the extent possible and will work from municipal plans.
- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions and expedite work.
- Please take care when walking near construction areas. Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians, as detours may be required.
- Work may be delayed or reschedule due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
